It is my great pleasure and distinct honor to extend to each of you a most cordial and fraternal welcome to the One Hundred and Eightieth Annual Convocation of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama. As we gather to conduct the business of our beloved order, I pray that each of us may be blessed with clear minds, willing hearts and a deep sense of brotherly love and affection.

To our visiting distinguished guests, I welcome you to Alabama and thank you for gracing us with your presence. The Companions of Alabama are grateful that you have elected to take time out of your busy schedules to be with us. Over the past year, I have met and developed new friendships with many of you while continuing to grow existing friendships with many others. I have always been greeted with true Masonic courtesy and affection in your several Grand Jurisdictions and I pledge the same to each of you while you are in our Grand Jurisdiction. If there is anything, we can do to make your stay with us more enjoyable, please let us know.

To those who are attending our Grand York Rite Convocation for the first time, I bid you a special welcome. You are the new strength which will sustain our order in the future. I hope you enjoy this gathering as much as I do and that it will become an annual event on your calendar. I encourage you to meet and talk to as many Companions as you can, especially our Grand Officers. Most importantly, give us your honest feedback about your visit. STATE OF THE CRAFT

Companions, at our last convocation, in addressing the Grand Chapter, I spoke of sharp divisions among our nations people and of the call of history for good men again to work together in unifying that which has become divided. While we gather in harmony and brotherhood, those sharp divisions still exist outside of our Craft. But, like our nation, this gentle Craft has been ordained and guided by God and like the American people, when aroused, Masons can overcome any hardship. We must first look to God for guidance, then look inside ourselves for motivation and finally look to our Brothers for reinforcement. As Cryptic Masons, we are the keepers and conservators of the mysteries, secrets and traditions of Masonry. While duty requires us to keep those secrets, it also requires us to wear Masonry proudly, proclaiming it to the world by our lives and deeds. Only in this way may we honestly encourage good men to unite with us, to join us in our crusade to improve ourselves and our world.

Companions, if we are to prosper our Craft, we must truly accept and perform those duties and responsibilities we assume towards good men when they unite with us. We as the keepers and conservators are also the teachers. As English is the common language uniting our nations people, so are our rituals the common language uniting our Craft. We must devote ourselves to ritual proficiency that we may demonstrate our love and reverence we learned from our predecessors and pass that love and reverence on to our successors. If we are not willing to learn and so to teach the language of our Craft, how can we be surprised when good men who unite with us tire of us and stray from us?

Companions, not everyone desires to be a ritualist and our order has many stations to be filled, many jobs to be done, but our ritual is that strong foundation upon which our institution is built. As no station or job is more important than any other, so no role in the ritual is more important. Some are more difficult, but if smallest goes role unfilled, the entire enterprise fails. Therefore, every Companion, no matter his preferred station or job, must also find his part in the ritual, proudly perform it and stand ready to teach it to a new Companion seeking light.

Companions, when new members experience our ritual work for the first time, they are invariably overwhelmed by its beauty and power. They are excited and thirsty to learn it for themselves. We must begin, at once and continue without fail to teach them what they desire to learn and, most importantly, to keep their spark alive. If we do this, we can be assured that these men will remain with us until they lay down their working tools and that our Craft will prosper long after we have passed onto that higher lodge we are approaching.

Ronald L. Thomas General Grand Council Ritual Award

Overview

A. General Considerations

- Ideally, a Companion's path to earning a ritual bar would be through service as an officer in a Cryptic Council over several years' tenure, learning to be proficient in the work going through the chairs and assisting in the leadership of several conferrals. Serving progressively from at least Conductor of the Council through Illustrious Master, and performing the roles associated with their respective chair, a Companion would be positioned to earn the ritual bars for the degrees. Especially talented ritualists who take more roles should be able to contribute more significantly to the degree work by taking on non- chair role parts of the ritual and would therefore be able to earn the distinction quicker.
- Some active and exemplary Cryptic ritualists have already served as an officer in their Council, District, or Grand Council. They should be afforded opportunities through the program to earn the distinction. Councils of Instruction at the district level or jurisdiction level as well as Statewide (Jurisdiction) Festivals are examples of these opportunities.
- Ritual is an important element of our craft and one deserving of flawless presentation. The expected standard of ritual delivery is from memory complete with full floor work. Our Cryptic ritual is deserving of the very best and near perfect rendition.
- Ideally, points are earned through degree conferrals at the Council, District or Statewide level.
- Public exemplification is useful to spread the knowledge of the degrees and may contribute to the earning of a ritual bar, but earning points through conferral of the degrees is preferred. Private exemplification is not allowed as may give rise to corruption or conflict of interest, "quid pro quo" situations. A ritual bar cannot be earned solely through exemplification.
- Ideally, points are earned through a work in a Council where the Companion is a member. Assisting other Councils is encouraged and points earned in those situations may contribute toward overall points.
- Ritual Award, Ritual Bars should not be something easily earned as will diminish the perceived distinction and value.
- The criteria should not be so onerous so as to dissuade Companions from seeking to earn the distinction.
- Certifiers who attest to a Companion's application should be qualified by both their official organizational position and their knowledge of the ritual. Certifiers would include past recipients of the **Ronald L. Thomas General Grand Council Ritual Award**, current Grand Lecturers/Instructors, current or past MIGMs, current Grand Recorders. Attestation by the Grand Recorder facilitated through the Council's Recorder to the qualification of the certifier should be provided.

II. Expected Impact and Outcomes

- By providing General Grand Council providing a recognition mechanism and therefore incentive, Companions will earn the reward through service as officers in their Council.
- Ritual delivery from memory will be re-established as a standard expectation. The reading of ritual will occur less frequently.

Ronald L. Thomas General Grand Council Ritual Award

- Overall, a larger population of Companions will be ritually proficient, and continue to do so as a function of time with the Ritual Award program in place.

III. Award Criteria

Recording period will commence February 27, 2016

Final date for this recording period to submit nomination will be September 1, 2020. Recording Periods will correspond to General Grand Council Triennial.

Upon the achievement of criteria for any one of the three degrees, a Companion's application can be completed and submitted to General Grand Council. The Grand Recorders of the various jurisdictions have nomination forms available for Companions who qualify.

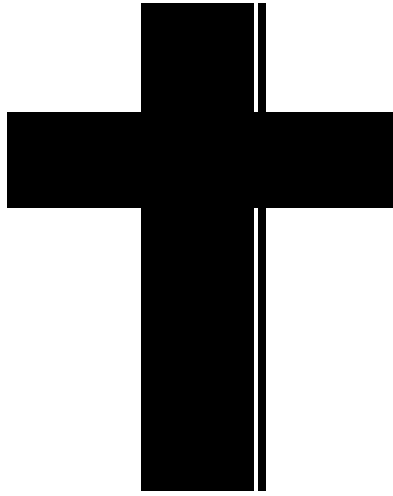

A....The Grand Council did not meet in the year 1840

B....The Grand Council met in 1842 but neither the printed proceedings nor original records show that any officers were elected.

C....In the year 1849 a new office was created, called "Grand Thrice Illustrious" ranking next to Deputy Grand Master, but in 1872 the office was abolished. The following were elected "Grand Thrice Illustrious": In 1849 J. McCaleb Wiley; in 1850 J. McCaleb Wiley; in 1851 William P. Chilton; in 1852 William A. Taylor; in 1852 Henry S. Shelton; in 1854 Stephen Ives; in 1855 William A. Ferrell; in 1856 Joshua H. Danforth; in 1857 Lewis B. Thornton; in 1858 Rufus c. Torrey; in 1859 Lewis B. Thornton; in 1860 John A. Lodor; in 1864 E. H. Bernhard; in 1865 William Kerr; in 1866 Paige Brown; in 1868 Robert H. Erwin; in 1869 James M.

D....The Grand Council did not meet in the years 1861, 1862 and 1863

E....For want of a Quorum, The Grand Council held no meeting in the year 1866

F....At the Annual Assembly in 1946, Companion John Terry, on account of ill health, was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Companion Frank A. Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.

G....On August 4, 1947, Companion Willis E. Glazner was appointed Acting Grand Recorder following the death of Companion Guy T. Smith.

H....At the Annual Assembly in 1947, Companion C. H. Stubinger was elected Grand Recorder

I....At the Annual Assembly of the Grand council of R. & S. M. of Alabama held on February 11, 1957, companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected Most Illustrious Grand Master to serve in that capacity during the election of officers. Most Illustrious Companion James M. Jones was elected Grand Recorder to serve for the same period of time.

J....On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas Leon Cochran was appointed Acting Grand Recorder

K....On September 16, 1960, following the resignation of Companion T. L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Recorder.

L....On December 1, 1960 companion Varna A. Rushton was Appointed Grand Recorder to succeed Gordon L. Evatt who resigned

M....Grand York Rite office was moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Recorder in 1962

N....At the Annual Assembly on February 1973 Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Recorder. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Recorder Emeritus.

O....Annual Assembly date changed to last Monday in February.

P....As proof of continual effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council, and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974

Q....On November 1, 1974, The Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 5th Avenue South, Birmingham, AL 35222

R....On October 1, 1979 the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504 ½ 1st Avenue North, Birmingham, AL 35212

S....on May 16, 1980, James A Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to Succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.

T....At the Annual Assembly, February 1981 Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus

U....On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Most Illustrious Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was appointed as Grand Recorder.

V....At the Annual Assembly in February 1992, Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and Most Illustrious Past Grand Master (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Most Illustrious Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Recorder.

W....On January 13, 1999 the Grand York Rite office moved to a new location at 3430 Ratliff Road, Birmingham, AL 35210

X....On October 1st William C. Havens Renounced Masonry. MacArthur Davis, Deputy Grand Master assumed the duties as Acting Grand Master and Presided over the Annual Assembly on February 23, 2003

Y....On December 31st, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned and Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Grand Recorder.

Z....At the Annual Assembly in February, 2006 Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and Most Illustrious Past Grand Master (honorary). Most Illustrious Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected as Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Recorder.

AA....On February 28th, 2013 Illustrious Grand Principal Conductor of the Work Companion Jack A. Elliott Died. Most Illustrious George L. Marshall, Jr. according to the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama Constitution moved all elected officers up one position in line except the Deputy Grand Master, Treasurer and Recorder. He appointed Companion Raymond C. Dunn as Sentinel. This was done at a meeting of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama March 9th, 2013 at Birmingham Metro York Rite Temple 3430 Ratliff Road, Birmingham, AL with an effective date of April 1st, 2013.
