I want to welcome our guest from other Grand Jurisdictions. I extend to you the assistance and services to make your stay a joyous event.

To the Grand Officers, Companions and Representatives of the subordinate Chapters of Alabama, thank you for attendance at this Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter. I hope you will be attentive to the business at hand.

**STATE OF THE CRAFT**

Companions York Rite Masonry is alive and well in Alabama. I started this year with a positive attitude about Masonry. I realize that we are still losing members, but I am optimistic about the future and I hope somewhere down this road, we can turn the corner and have a gain in membership. In June 2005 I appointed Companion Ricky C. Kilgore to replace Dwight M. Hollan as Right Excellent Grand Chaplain. Companion Hollan moved to Kingsport, Tennessee, because of his job. On December 5, 2005, I appointed Companion Patrick Donahey to replace C. F. Pate, Jr. as Grand Sentinel. Companion Pate resigned in December. I accepted the resignations of Grand Secretary Arthur C. Harding and Grand Treasurer Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. I appointed Hiram Williams as Acting Grand Secretary and Robert Grigsby as Acting Grand Treasurer.

### **OUT OF STATE VISITS**

My wife, Stephanie and I were granted traveling mercies as we visited the Grand Chapters in South Carolina, Georgia, and North Carolina. We were graciously received with courtesies extended warmly. I could not visit Tennessee because of schedule conflicts with North Carolina.

We Attended the Southeast York Rite Conference in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee. It was a great Masonic affair with excellent speakers. I enjoyed it very much.

### **IN STATE VISITS**

I regret that I did not get to visit every chapter in the state. It was my intention but rising fuel costs did hinder me to some extent. I was fortunate to visit Anniston No. 105, Woodlawn No. 146, Piedmont No. 111, Birmingham Metro No. 76, Montgomery No. 22, Coosa No. 86, and Eunomia No. 5.

On September 7, I, along with Right Eminent Commander Thomas F. Craig and Companion V. Lloyd Llewellyn, Right Illustrious Grand Master visited DeKalb-Jackson No. 46. Also in attendance were Raymond C. Dunn, Right Excellent Grand Scribe; Paul Drinkard, Right Excellent Grand Master of the Second Veil; and Right Eminent Past Grand Commanders George Marshall and Bobby Terry. Although written and oral notifications were sent that we would be coming on that day, only five members were present and no attempt was made to open the bodies. No request was made for the bodies to be declared open. An informal discussion was held to talk about their problems.

I came away from DeKalb-Jackson with the feeling that the York Rite Bodies are not viable. The Charter has been under dispensation for two years. It is my recommendation to arrest the Charter per Article II Section 3 and issue demits to the members. I feel very strongly that the Charter would fare much better if it was relocated back to Fort Payne, Alabama.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

Companions, it is vital to our future that we work closely with the Blue Lodges. They need us and we need them. The symbolic degrees are the first three degrees of the York Rite. We need to

attend Lodge and participate in the Ritual. The Blue Lodge is the only source of new members. Less than ten percent of Masons in Alabama are in the York Rite Bodies.

Although our numbers are less, the charities we support are still there relying on us as York Rite Masons to fulfill our obligations to them.

I would also recommend that each body that each body add one more member to the Finance Committee. The committee could be called the Convention/Finance Committee. This would allow them to arrange our Grand Sessions and negotiate with the hotels. This committee would know how much they could spend. The cost of the hotels has increased considerably in recent years.

### CONCLUSION

Companions, I want to thank you for allowing me the opportunity to serve as Grand High Priest this past year. It has indeed been a pleasure and a privilege to represent the Grand Chapter of Alabama. It has truly been the highlight of my life.

I want to thank all of the Grand Chapter officers, elected and appointed, for their support and friendship. I thank our Right Eminent Grand Commander Thomas F. I thank you, Honey, and love you very, very much.

We your audit committee have reviewed the books and records of the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Alabama for the period 1 January 2005 through 31 December 2005. We found no discrepancies in the records we reviewed that would lead us to believe that a modification to the financial statements would be warranted. In our review we discovered some areas of the records of the Grand Chapter that need updating. We have made comments concerning these areas in the Notes to Financial Statements section of this report.

It is common for the Grand Secretary and the Grand Treasurer to change in the same year; it is also common for a full audit to be performed by a qualified firm to be conducted on the records of the preceding officers. While we found nothing that would lead the committee to believe that everything was not in order, no one knows what the future may or may not discover. We the committee commends the current Grand Secretary and Grand Treasurer for accepting the call to serve this Grand Body without a full audit of the records being performed. With this in mind we recommend a motion be put forth absolving the 2006 elected Grand Secretary and Grand Treasurer for any and all acts that may relate to the financial records before they took office.

Notes to Financial Statements  
For the period ending December 31, 2005**

**Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

**Basis of Accounting**

The Grand Chapter's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

**Inventories**

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the First-in; first-out method of market.

\*\*The committee feels that the inventory numbers need updating since we could not find records indicating when the inventory was last updated.

**Property and Equipment**

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

**Note 2 - Tax Status**

**Note 3 - Restricted Assets**

A Triennial Reserve account is established as a reserve to cover expenses for specific officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year there was an increase in the balance of this reserve account to \$ 2,800.00

## REPORT OF COMMITTEE FOR RESEARCH ASSISTANCE

*To the Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Grand Officers, and  
Companions of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Alabama*

Companions I know that by now you must get tired of hearing me say the we still rank number 19 in giving to the Royal Arch Research Assistance but we have been stuck in that spot for many years now and to think that at one time we were ranked number 1. The problem with us moving up to 18th in the rankings and take that spot from Utah, a jurisdiction with less than 500 members, we have to overcome a difference of over \$25,000.00.

We had 4 Chapters who received 100% certificates; Anniston No. 105, Monroeville, No. 170, Eunomia No. 5 and Mobile No. 21. Decatur No. 38 was \$34.00 short of being 100%, Cyrus No. 6 was \$43.00 short of being 100% and Dothan No. 113 was \$28.00 short of being 100%. For an additional \$101.00 from these Chapters we could have had 3 more 100% certificates.

We had 6 Chapters that made no contribution at all; Tuscaloosa No. 1, Montgomery No. 22, Coosa No. 86, DeKalb-Jackson No. 107, Piedmont No. 111 and Phenix City No. 149.

While Alabama ranks number 19 in total contributions we rank dead last in the Southeast, and way down on the list of all jurisdictions, in memorial contributions having only given a total of \$2,470.00.

Royal Arch Research Assistance continues to support the Center for Central Auditory Research through the Able Kids Foundation with Dr. Joan Burleigh, Ph.D. as the Director of the clinic. The transition from the Colorado State University to the Able Kids Foundation has slowed the research efforts somewhat because the University has maintained possession of all the equipment that was used in the research there. Much of that equipment was purchased by Royal Arch Research Assistance but the University considers those items a gift and maintains ownership. Consequently the staff at Able Kids has had to purchase almost all new equipment which will make the clinic one of the most up-to-date facilities of it's kind. A new state-of-the-art double-wall sound-proof suite was installed in September 2005 and other equipment purchased includes a Grason-Stadler Middle Ear Analyzer and an Audioscan, model Verifit, system for electroacoustic and acoustic measurements. The auditory laboratory consists of a suite of rooms that houses the sound proof room, waiting room, two offices, sink area and a secure room for client files.

While the research we support for Central Auditory Processing Disorders benefits both children and adults it is the children that can benefit the most if their problem can be detected at an early age. Dr. Burleigh and her staff diagnose about thirty patients a week and there is an extremely long waiting list to be diagnosed. Those patients come from all the fifty state and many foreign countries. Your donations do make a difference in peoples lives and that is one of the primary goals of our fraternity.

You may be interested to know that Most Excellent Companion Larry E. Gray, General Grand High Priest, has appointed me to serve on the Board of Directors for the Able Kids Foundation and, of course, by my station as General Grand King I serve automatically on the Board of Directors for the Royal Arch Research Foundation.

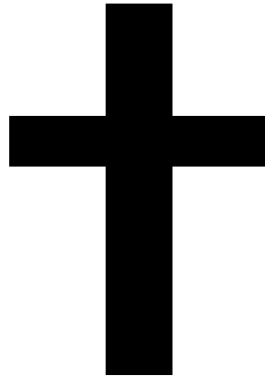

- A. May, 1823: A Small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- B. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- C. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore reorganized in June, 1827 and a new constitution adopted.
- D. December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- E. July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- F. No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14<sup>th</sup>, until the next evening, but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- G. There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwars of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocation fixed for December.
- H. In 1925 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
- I. At the Annual Convocation in December, 1944, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
- J. At Annual Convocation in 1946, on account of ill health, companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
- K. On August 4, 1947, following the death of companion Guy T. Smith, companion W. E. Glazner was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
- L. At the Annual Convocation, November, 1947, Companion Charles W. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary.

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- M. At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1956, Companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers.
- N. On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
- O. On September 16, 1960 following the resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
- P. On December 1, 1960, Companion Varna A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Evatt, who had resigned.
- Q. Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
- R. At Annual Convocation, February, 1973, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
- S. Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
- T. As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity , the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.
- U. On November 1, 1974, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
- V. On October 1, 1979, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504 ½ North 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.
- W. On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
- X. At Annual Convocation, February, 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
- Y. On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
- Z. At the Annual Convocation in February, 1992 Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Past Grand High Priest (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was Elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary.
- AA. At the Annual Convocation, February, 2003 Jesse W. Locke was elected Grand High Priest Honorary by a unanimous vote.
- BB. On December 31, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned. Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- CC. At the Annual convocation, February, 2006 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Arthur C, Harding was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Secretary.
