Notes to Financial Statements  
For the period ending December 31, 2007**

**Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

**A. Basis of Accounting**

The Grand Chapter's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

**B. Inventories**

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the First-in; first-out method of market.

**C. Property and Equipment**

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

**Note 2 - Tax Status**

The Grand Chapter is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501©, and from state income tax under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990.

**Note 3 - Restricted Assets**

## REPORT OF COMMITTEE FOR RESEARCH ASSISTANCE

### *To the Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Grand Officers, and Companions of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Alabama*

The support of Royal Arch Research Assistance by our Chapters here in Alabama is amiable but as always can be better than it is. Our Total contributions last year were \$3,268.90 but \$1,101.00 of that amount was from outside sources leaving \$2,167.90 that were actually contributed by the Chapters. Four Chapters, Mobile, Eunomia, Anniston and Montgomery contributed \$1,425.00 of that amount leaving \$742.90 contributed by the other 10 Chapters. Actually that amount was given by 7 Chapters as there were 3 Chapters that made no contribution, Tuscaloosa, Coosa and Piedmont. If all the Chapters in Alabama would contribute at least \$1.00 per member, as Royal Arch Research Assistance ask, we could increase our contributions by \$887.00

Royal Arch Research Assistance and Able Kids Foundation has become increasingly important to me, not only because I serve both on the Board of Directors and as the elected Treasurer for the Able Kids Foundation but because I now have a better understanding as to just what has been accomplished through the donations that Royal Arch Research Assistance has made in funding research for a solution to correcting the problem of Audio Perception Disabilities. I have been made more aware of exactly what those who have the problem are experiencing since one of my grandsons was diagnosed with the problem and the change that it has made in his life since being diagnosed by Dr. John Burleigh and her staff at the Able Kids Foundation.

Allen was actually diagnosed with the problem in Georgia but was told that there was nothing that could be done to correct it. Fortunately when I learned what his problem was I knew that there was a possible way to correct it. On consultation with Dr. Burleigh an appointment was made for Allen to be evaluated and he and my daughter Yvette made the trip to Ft. Collins, Colorado where Allen was evaluated and fitted with a filter for his ear to eliminate the background noise which plagued his ability to function in school as well as we all knew that he was capable of doing. In 9 short weeks Allen went from just getting by in school to the AB Honor Roll. All this came about because of research money donated by Royal Arch Research Assistance.

Royal Arch Research Assistance contributes money to Able Kids Foundation for research only. We were able to increase our contribution to Able Kids this year from \$220,000.00 to \$240,000.00. Most of those contributions come from our investments so consequently what the stock market does influences the amount we can contribute. This past year was a very good year for the market.

The diagnostic side of Able Kids is supported in part by individual donations, some small grants and a small charge for evaluations, filters and other hearing devices. The cost to a family for consultation, diagnosis and filter is \$450.00. However there is a scholarship fund, which is funded by individual donations, for families that cannot afford transportation, motel and the full cost of the visit. That scholarship is on a sliding scale and is funded by individual donations. Just this past week a young man and his mother from the Huntsville area made the trip to Ft. Collins for evaluation. Because of the financial burden that the family could not afford the families church paid for air fare and motel for the mother and son and Eunomia Chapter No. 5 in Huntsville paid the balance on his scholarship which after being prorated was \$201.35.

So you see Companions your money is at work and doing something worthwhile for mankind, not only in this country but throughout the world, as Able Kids has evaluated clients not only from almost every state in the US but from foreign countries as well.

Thank you for your continued support.

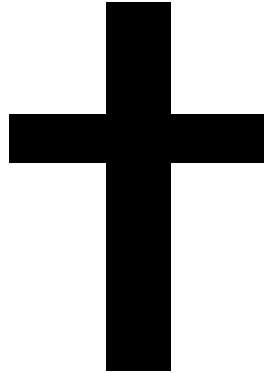

- A. May, 1823: A Small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- B. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- C. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore reorganized in June, 1827 and a new constitution adopted.
- D. December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- E. July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- F. No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14<sup>th</sup>, until the next evening, but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- G. There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocation fixed for December.
- H. In 1925 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.

- I. At the Annual Convocation in December, 1944, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
  - J. At Annual Convocation in 1946, on account of ill health, companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
  - K. On August 4, 1947, following the death of companion Guy T. Smith, companion W. E. Glazner was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
  - L. At the Annual Convocation, November, 1947, Companion Charles W. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary.
  - M. At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1956, Companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers.
  - N. On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
  - O. On September 16, 1960 following the resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
  - P. On December 1, 1960, Companion Varna A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Evatt, who had resigned.
  - Q. Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
  - R. At Annual Convocation, February, 1973, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
  - S. Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
  - T. As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity , the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.
  - U. On November 1, 1974, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
  - V. On October 1, 1979, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504 ½ North 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.
  - W. On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
  - X. At Annual Convocation, February, 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
  - Y. On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
  - Z. At the Annual Convocation in February, 1992 Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Past Grand High Priest (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was Elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary.
  - AA. At the Annual Convocation, February, 2003 Jesse W. Locke was elected Grand High Priest Honorary by a unanimous vote.
  - BB. On December 31, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned. Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
  - CC. At the Annual convocation, February, 2006 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Secretary.
