Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

A. Basis of Accounting

The Grand Chapter's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

B. Inventories

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the First-in; first-out method of market.

C. Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

Note 2 - Tax Status

The Grand Chapter is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501©, and from state income tax under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990.

Note 3 - Restricted Assets

A Triennial Reserve account is established as a reserve to cover expenses for specific officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year there was no increase in the balance of this reserve account which remained at the amount of \$ 2,250.00

To those Chapters that made a contribution to the Royal Arch Research Assistance for 2012, I thank you very much. To those five Chapters that made not contributions I ask you to make a more concerted effort to assist those who did. The five Chapters that made no contributions were Decatur, Coosa, Tuscaloosa, Monroeville and Piedmont. A small donation of \$1.00 per member will be recognized with a 100% certificate from RARA.

We are fortunate to have had eight Chapters that received 100% certificates for 2012 and those Chapters were Eunomia, Montgomery, Dothan, Cyrus, Phenix City, Mobile, Anniston and Ft. Payne.

Our contributions to RARA in 2012 were \$3,394.75 and Alabama has advanced to 17th in total contributions, something that we can all be proud of but, if all our Chapters were to support the philanthropy we could do much better. Alabama does not even rank in memorial contributions.

I think that most of you know that Royal Arch Research Assistance no longer supports Able Kids Foundation but is now supporting three other foundations. Hearing Health Foundation, Autism Speaks and the Research Department of Connecticut University and I am certain most of you know the circumstances that necessitated the change. All of these foundations are continuing research for the benefit of Central Audio Processing Disorders. RARA awarded \$100,000.00 to both Hearing Health Foundation and Autism Speaks and \$60,000.00 to the University of Connecticut for 2012.

I think most of you know that my grandson Allen has CAPD and that he was evaluated and fitted for a filter at Able Kids Foundation. No one can tell his story better than he can himself so I am including a copy of the paper he wrote that was published in the Royal Arch Magazine and since few of you subscribe to the magazine I will read you that paper at the conclusion of this report.

I will tell you that though Hearing Health, Autism Speaks and the University of Connecticut are wonderful foundations and I know that they are working hard to find an instrument to assist those with CAPD. I also know that none of the three have come up with any kind of solution to the problem that works as well as the filter that Able Kids Foundation has perfected. I encourage you to continue to recommend Able Kids to any one that you know that may need a solution to treating Central Audio Processing Disorders.

CAPD A CHALLENGE

Having CAPD has been a challenge for me, but looking back now I know it was more of a challenge not knowing why I did so badly in school. I use to think I was not smart, even though I retained the knowledge; I never seem to be able to recall anything I learned during school or on tests. I remember having to stay up for hours on school nights struggling though homework with my mom. One night in particular we stayed up till two in the morning trying to get it all done. Every night was a yelling match because I would fight and argue all the way through. Little did my family know I was suffering with a weak auditory processing system or CAPD.

CAPD is a disorder in which you do not retain knowledge correctly because your ears hear too much. My brain could not decide what the most important material to remember was. My friends class notes might be five pages long and I would not have one page of notes because nothing made sense. My personal experience has been unusual but has made for some good stories because I can hear thing most people cannot. For instance, my family and I went away for Christmas one year after I had received my ear filter. Upon returning home when I entered the house there was the most intense high pitch ringing sound I had ever heard. I began stumbling around in a mad frenzy trying to locate from where the noise was coming, after a few minutes I finally found out that the noise had been coming from our DVD player, which while we were gone had

died and was making a high pitched sound. My parents looked on in confusion not knowing why I was rampaging around our house talking about a noise they couldn't hear. That is how severe some situations are for me.

When I was first diagnosed with CAPD and we bought my filter, I was embarrassed for my friends to know I wore the filter every day for help. In recent years I have grown to not care if people know I have an ear filter and a disorder. Although I have had my share of people making fun of me, after showing people how powerful my hearing is because of the disorder people have made comments like, "WOW! That's like a super power!" So I guess some people find it kind of intriguing which make me feel a lot better about having CAPD. I do sometimes over hear people's conversations and they may be quite a ways away from me. This can be a bad thing considering the things my generation thinks are trendy topics to discuss. I can say that CAPD has been less of a stressful thing in my life every passing year.

I am kind of proud how far I have come since finally being diagnosed and having accommodations put in place. I have learned to play 10 or 11 instruments, maintained a high GPA after receiving my ear filter, and have just become a better person because of my ear filter. That last one is no stretch either; I literally became a better person. Before I had my ear filter I was really hard to be around. I was aggressive and mean. Ever since I got my ear filter I have become a nicer and more caring person. It is really weird to see such a big difference in my life. You can literally see in pictures of the last four or so years where I just genuinely have become happier. Thank you to the York Rite for providing funds through RARA to the Able Kids Foundation's research for developing the ear filter. I cannot thank the York Rite enough for providing funds and the Able Kids Foundation for finding my problem and fixing it. It has changed me in so many ways for the better.

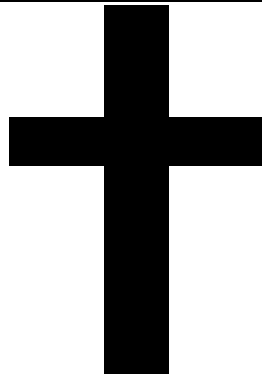

He grew up in Odessa graduating from Permian High School and attending Odessa Junior College studying electronics. While serving in the U.S. Army he married Brenda J. Taylor a native of West Texas and they have been together for fifty years. Jack and Brenda moved from Texas to Birmingham in 1971. Jack attended the University of Alabama at Birmingham receiving his BS degree and was employed by Southern Railway in 1977. Jack and Brenda both retired in January 2008, he from Norfolk Southern Railway after thirty plus years of service and she from Robins & Morton General Contractors after twenty-seven years of service.

Masonic History

- A. May, 1823: A Small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- B. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- C. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore reorganized in June, 1827 and a new constitution adopted.
- D. December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- E. July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.

- F. No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14th, until the next evening, but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- G. There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocation fixed for December.
- H. In 1925 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
- I. At the Annual Convocation in December, 1944, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
- J. At Annual Convocation in 1946, on account of ill health, companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
- K. On August 4, 1947, following the death of companion Guy T. Smith, companion W. E. Glazner was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
- L. At the Annual Convocation, November, 1947, Companion Charles W. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary.
- M. At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1956, Companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers.
- N. On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
- O. On September 16, 1960 following the resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
- P. On December 1, 1960, Companion Varna A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Evatt, who had resigned.
- Q. Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
- R. At Annual Convocation, February, 1973, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
- S. Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
- T. As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.
- U. On November 1, 1974, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5th Avenue Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
- V. On October 1, 1979, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504 ½ North 1st Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.
- W. On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
- X. At Annual Convocation, February, 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
- Y. On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
- Z. At the Annual Convocation in February, 1992 Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Past Grand High Priest (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was Elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary.
- AA. At the Annual Convocation, February, 2003 Jesse W. Locke was elected Grand High Priest Honorary by a unanimous vote.

- BB. On December 31, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned. Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- CC. At the Annual convocation, February, 2006 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Secretary.

- DD. The Right Excellent Grand King Arthur Lee Campbell, III resigned from all Masonic functions on October 1st, 2013 thru e-mail with no explanation stated to the Grand Secretary-Recorder.

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
