Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

A. Basis of Accounting

The Grand Chapter's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

B. <u>Inventories</u>

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the First-in; first-out method of market.

C. Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

Note 2 - Tax Status

The Grand Chapter is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501©, and from state income tax under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990.

Note 3 - Restricted Assets

Thomas F. Craig Grand High Priest 2014-2014

Thomas Franklin Craig was born February 26, 1943, in Indianapolis, Indiana, to Robert W. and Iris E. Craig. He attended Elementary and Junior High School in Cleveland, Ohio, and graduated from Speedway High School in Speedway City, Indiana, in 1961. He graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering from Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana, in 1965, and earned a Master of Science in Industrial Administration in 1970 from that same institution. He served on active duty in the United States Army Reserve in the Ordnance Corps from 1965 to 1968, rising to the rank of Captain. During that period, he met his wife, Annelle Cantrell, to whom he has been married for 36 years. They have two daughters, Amy Craig-Hefele in Lawrenceville, New Jersey, and Josie Craig in Huntsville. He currently is a retired engineer. Before his retirement, he worked on other military and space systems, including the Ground-based Midcourse Defense program, the Avenger Slew-to-Cue program, the International Space Station, the Exoatmospheric Reentry Vehicle Interceptor System, the Stinger Air Defense System, the Pershing Weapon System, the Patriot Weapon System, the SAFEGUARD System, the HAWK Air Defense System, the Nike-Hercules Weapon System, the TOW Weapon System, and the Dragon Weapon System. He is a member of several technical and professional societies related to his work.

Companion Craig has been a member of First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Huntsville since 1966. He has served a member of the Church Official Board and as chairman. He has also served as Deacon and Elder and as Chairman of the Board of Elders for several terms. He has taught several adult and youth Sunday School classes and has served on several committees, including the nominating committee, the building committee and the outreach committee.

In the community, he served as Assistant Treasurer for the Huntsville Depot Museum Board from 1978 to1984 and as Member of the Huntsville Depot Museum Advisory Board from 1991 to 1995. He was also member of the Community Ballet Association Board of Directors from 1981 to 1995, which he served as Treasurer from 1986 to 1988. He also served as Treasurer for the Huntsville Literary Association from 1994 to 1996.

Companion Craig was initiated September 19, 1973, in Apollo Lodge No. 921, Huntsville, Alabama; passed October 17, 1973; and raised October 31, 1973. He served as Worshipful Master in 1978-79, as Historian in 1996-97 and as Chaplain in 1997-99. He has served the Grand Lodge as Vice-Chairman of the Grand Lodge Education Committee in 1991-92.

In the York Rite he was exalted in Eunomia Chapter No. 5 on November 1, 1975, and served as High Priest in 1979-80. He received the Order of High Priesthood in 1980. In the Grand Chapter he has been Grand Representative from New Brunswick since 1987 and served as Grand Sentinel in 1987-88.

He received the Cryptic Degrees in Eureka Council No. 5 (then known as Monte Sano Council No. 84) on November 1, 1975, and served as Illustrious Master in 1980-81. He received the Order of the Silver Trowel in 1982 and served as Thrice Illustrious Master in 2009. In the Grand Council, he has been Grand Representative from Kentucky since 1990. He has also served on the Grand Council Fraternal Correspondence Committee from 1986 to 1988, on the Grand Council Ritualistic Committee in 1979-80, the Grand Council Constitution and By-Laws Committee in 2012 and as Grand Marshal in 1996-7.

He was knighted in Huntsville Commandery No. 7, on March 15, 1976 and served that body as Eminent Commander in 1982-83. He was initiated into the Knight Crusaders of the Cross in 1984. In the Grand Commandery, he has served as Editor for the Knight Templar Magazine Supplement since 1984. He has also served as Grand Representative from Vermont since 1988. He was a member of the Templar Education (Blue Ribbon) Committee in 1988-89. He was awarded the Knight Templar Cross of Honor in 1989 and made a Knight Commander of the Temple in 1996. He became a member of the Grand Commander's Club, Knight Templar Eye Foundation, in 1998. He served as Right Eminent Grand Commander in 2005.

He was accepted as a Knight of York Cross of Honour in Alabama Priory No. 31 in 1983. - A. May, 1823: A Small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- B. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- C. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore reorganized in June, 1827 and a new constitution adopted.
- D. December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- E. July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- F. No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14th, until the next evening, but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- G. There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocation fixed for December.
- H. In 1925 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
- I. At the Annual Convocation in December, 1944, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
- J. At Annual Convocation in 1946, on account of ill health, companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
- K. On August 4, 1947, following the death of companion Guy T. Smith, companion W. E. Glazner was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
- L. At the Annual Convocation, November, 1947, Companion Charles W. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary. M. At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1956, Companion Charles H.
- Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers. N. On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was
- appointed acting Grand Secretary.
- 0. On September 16, 1960 following the resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
- P. On December 1, 1960, Companion Varna A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Evatt, who had resigned.
- Q. Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
- R. At Annual Convocation, February, 1973, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
- S. Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
- T. As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.
- U. On November 1, 1974, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5th Avenue Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
- V. On October 1, 1979, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504 ½ North 1st Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.
- W. On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
- X. At Annual Convocation, February, 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
- Y. On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A, Kile resigned and Companion Fred W.McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
- Z. At the Annual Convocation in February, 1992 Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Past Grand High Priest (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was Elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary.
- AA. At the Annual Convocation, February, 2003 Jesse W. Locke was elected Grand High Priest Honorary by a unanimous vote.
- BB. On December 31, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned. Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- CC. At the Annual convocation, February, 2006 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Arthur C, Harding was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Secretary.
- DD. The Right Excellent Grand King Arthur Lee Campbell, III resigned from all Masonic functions on October 1st, 2013 thru e-mail with no explanation stated to the Grand Secretary-Recorder.

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
