ADDRESS OF THE MOST EXCELLENT GRAND HIGH PRIEST

THOMAS F. CRAIG

2014-2015

To the Officers, Past Grand High Priests, Companions and Distinguished Guests of the Most Excellent Grand Royal Arch Chapter of the State of Alabama:

STATE OF THE CRAFT

Although I have not heard at the time I am writing this what our membership situation is, I fear that it will be similar to the last several years, with a loss of 8 – 12% of our members. We are all concerned about these membership trends, and unfortunately it seems to be found throughout the craft. My counterpart as Grand Representative in the Grand Chapter of New Brunswick reports that his own Chapter has gone dark due to loss in membership, and the Membership Chairman for the Quatuor Coronati Correspondence Circle in London expressed the same concern when I reported membership in the Circle for Alabama.

Although the concern is real, we must remember that Masonry has survived three other great crises in our history. The first was almost three hundred years ago at the founding of the Premiere Grand Lodge in 1717. Although independent lodges existed prior to that time, the idea of a Grand Lodge was new and for the first few years of the existence of that Premiere Grand Lodge in London, it was not clear that the idea would survive, as several of the founding lodges disappeared and rival grand lodges sprang up. Nevertheless, Masonry as we know it survived that period.

The next crisis was nearly two hundred years ago, in the 1830's, and although it was confined to the United States, several of our Grand Lodges went dark for several years as a result of the popular anti-Masonic movement of those days. A number of Masonic writers have written about the Brethren who kept the Masonic lamp lit through those times, and we must be grateful to them for their perseverance.

STATE OF THE CRAFT

(Continued)

The Great Depression of the 1930's was another world-wide crisis that threatened many lodges with insolvency. Reading some of the literature, many lodges were dependent on interest rates on their investments rather than income from dues to operate, and found that both sources were inadequate under the conditions of the time.

We now seem to be in a fourth great crisis, which also seems to be world-wide. The causes are not clear (at least to me), whether it's technology (I've seen predictions of disappearance of religion due to the prevalence of social media, and other polls showing a disengagement of people from civic activities such as voting, volunteering and other activities due to perhaps the same thing) or something within ourselves. Nearly fifty years ago we were blaming television, although it's still here with a greatly expanded number of channels and we're still here. Although I'm not wise enough to see the causes and the solutions, I can see efforts at many levels to try to reverse these trends that concern us so much. Efforts at the local level, such as holding open houses and Masonic Days; at the state level, where Grand Bodies seek new ways of approaching training and participation; and at the higher levels such as our General Grand Chapter's training programs.

As I said, I don't know what the solutions are, but I'm optimistic that we will find those solutions and implement them, not just for our sakes as members of this fraternity, but for the sake of the world. Quite frankly, I would mourn for a society in which Friendship, Morality, and Brotherly Love, as well as all our other ideals, are no longer held in any esteem.

NECROLOGY

While our Grand Line has remained intact, we all mourn the loss of our Most Excellent Past Grand High Priest Malcolm W. Killingsworth, as well as all other Companions of the Order. Our Right Excellent Grand Chaplain, Most Excellent Companion George L. Marshall, will give a complete report in his Necrology Report later.

DISPENSATIONS

I gave dispensation to Cyrus Chapter No. 6 in Florence to hold out of turn elections.

Although not precisely a dispensation, I gave approval to Companion Mike Feld to conduct the Masonry United Walk for Autism in Birmingham under the auspices of the Grand Chapter.

VISITATIONS

Although I had intended to make various visitations, family health issues arose this past year that prevented my doing so, and I deeply regret not being able to perform that function as I feel it should have been done.

RECOMMENDATIONS

At the beginning of my term, I had asked for an official list of our Grand Representatives, since it appeared that there were at least twenty-one vacancies. Although the concept of Grand Representative is a subject of debate over its usefulness, I enjoy corresponding with my counterparts in other jurisdictions. There may be further vacancies now, but I feel that this is an important function the usefulness of which many representatives on both sides fail to take complete advantage, and that the vacancies should be filled.

We need to continue pursuing new avenues of making our principles known through activities such as the Walk for Autism.

We need to emphasize training of our members – all of them (as Brother Allen Roberts said, “The person who says he’s too old to learn probably always was.”) - So that they will be better empowered to explain our fraternity to the world and particularly to potential members. Not all members will be able or willing to take available training, but it should be open to anyone who is willing to invest the necessary time and effort into receiving it.

CONCLUSION

I need to express my appreciation to our Grand Secretary, Companion Hiram Williams, and his wife Cindy for maintaining our Grand York Rite office. Also Companion Joe Lee for his task in maintaining our finances an often disheartening task in times like this. But most of all, I want to thank the Companions who have been able to come to our meeting today and show their belief in our fraternity with their presence. Their efforts and the work of those Companions who were not able to come but continue to support our bodies throughout the state must be acknowledged. Finally, and most importantly, I have to thank my wife Annelle for all her help, support and advice throughout this term and throughout my career.

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Note 1 – Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

A. Basis of Accounting

The Grand Chapter's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

B. Inventories

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the first-in; first-out method of market.

C. Property and Equipment

Property and Equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

Note 2 – Tax Status

The Grand Chapter is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code section 501c, and from state income tax under Alabama code section 40-18-32, An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990N.

Note 3 – Restricted Assets

A Triennial reserve account is established as a reserve to cover expenses for specific officers to attend the Triennial meeting. During the year there was no increase in the balance of this reserve account and was reduced by expense to a balance of \$1,800.00.

REPORT OF COMMITTEE FOR RESEARCH ASSISTANCE

To the Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Grand Officers, and Companions of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Alabama.

Though the contributions to Royal Arch Research Assistance were down by \$578.00, from \$3,479 to \$2,901 in 2014 Alabama still maintained its rank of 17th in giving. Still it is certain that if our contributions continue to decrease our rankings in giving to RARA will decrease as well.

One of the reasons that our contributions dropped was because we had an unusual number of Chapters that made no contributions at all and those Chapters were: Decatur NO. 38, Monroeville No. 170, Montgomery No. 22, Piedmont No. 11, and Woodlawn No. 146.

We are fortunate that we had 2 Chapters that contributed \$500.00 each and those were Mobile No. 21 and Anniston No. 105. We also received donations from the York Rite Ladies Craft Room in the amount of \$360.00, donation made at the Devine Service in the amount of \$102.00, donations from appendant bodies in the amount of \$30.00 and donations from individuals in the amount of \$270.00. If we relied only on Chapter Contributions I am afraid that our donations to RARA would be dismal indeed.

I will remind you once again it takes a mere \$1.00 donation per member of your Chapter membership to be 100% in giving to the philanthropy. Not a great deal of money to ask from your Chapter.

Remember, Freemasons are known for their contributions to charity and RARA has a charity that is well worthwhile in supporting.

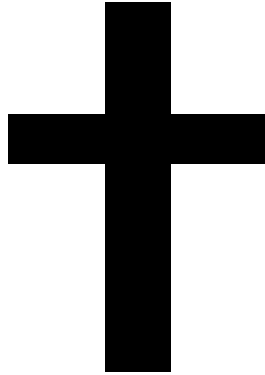

Companion Ron taught history and English at Rehobeth High School for 7 years and was counselor there for 3 years before becoming Houston County Schools' vocational counselor and counseling coordinator, positions he held until his retirement in 1998. Following retirement, Companion Ron formed Union Professional Services, Inc., an educational consulting company which he operates to the present. He married Gayle Gamble in 1967, and they have one daughter, Caitlin, who is a registered nurse. Companion Ron and Gayle, their grandson Jonathon, and their daughter Caitlin and her husband Keith all live on the family farm in central Henry County. An avid hunter and outdoorsman, he is also involved in several civic activities: Charter president of the Henry County Historical Group, Inc., and associate editor of its quarterly magazine; reserve deputy with the Henry County Sheriff's Office; treasurer of the Friends of the Alabama Archives; member of the board of the Alabama Historical Association; member of Haleburg United Methodist Church where he served as chairman of the administrative board; secretary of the Dothan Landmarks Foundation; member of the Houston County Children's Policy Council; board chairman of the Bethlehem Walk to Emmaus Community; and member of several other historical associations and hunting clubs. Foot Notes:

- A. May, 1823: A Small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- B. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- C. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore reorganized in June, 1827 and a new constitution adopted.
- D. December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- E. July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- F. No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14th, until the next evening, but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- G. There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocation fixed for December.
- H. In 1925 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
- I. At the Annual Convocation in December, 1944, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
- J. At Annual Convocation in 1946, on account of ill health, companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
- K. On August 4, 1947, following the death of companion Guy T. Smith, companion W. E. Glazner was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
- L. At the Annual Convocation, November, 1947, Companion Charles W. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary.
- M. At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1956, Companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers.
- N. On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was appointed acting Grand Secretary.

- O. On September 16, 1960 following the resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
- P. On December 1, 1960, Companion Varna A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Evatt, who had resigned.
- Q. Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
- R. At Annual Convocation, February, 1973, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
- S. Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
- T. As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.
- U. On November 1, 1974, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5th Avenue Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
- V. On October 1, 1979, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504 ½ North 1st Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.
- W. On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
- X. At Annual Convocation, February, 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
- Y. On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
- Z. At the Annual Convocation in February, 1992 Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Past Grand High Priest (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was Elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary.
- AA. At the Annual Convocation, February, 2003 Jesse W. Locke was elected Grand High Priest Honorary by a unanimous vote.

- BB. On December 31, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned. Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- CC. At the Annual convocation, February, 2006 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Secretary.

- DD. The Right Excellent Grand King Arthur Lee Campbell, III resigned from all Masonic functions on October 1st, 2013 thru e-mail with no explanation stated to the Grand Secretary-Recorder.
- EE. Most Excellent Grand High Priest Ronald L. Thomas died on March 30th 2015 after being in office 30 Days In office. Right Excellent Grand King Thomas H. Nesbit pro-tem as Most Excellent Grand High Priest for The remainder of the year. Also Right Excellent Grand Treasurer Joe D. Lee resigned at the February 2015 meeting due to health problems after serving 10 years and 2 months as Grand Treasurer. Companion Edward L. Mason was elected Grand Treasurer my majority vote.
