To all of our distinguished visitors and guests from our sister jurisdictions we extend to you our most hospitable and courteous stay while you our visiting and we pray that your journey home will be a safe one.

If there is anything any of us may do to make your visit a more enjoyable one, please do not hesitate to ask me or any of the officers know.

STATE OF THE CRAFT

It is my fear and unfortunate feelings that our craft is declining at an alarming rate in some areas of the state and making a slow, but steady incline or staying the same in others.

In the world we live in today things are not taken in consideration as they once were, most people are taking themselves in consideration, rather than considering the other person. Unfortunately that train of thought is severely damaging our fraternity, not only in the appellate bodies, but in Masonry as a whole. We are burying more brothers and companions than we are raising; and everyday more fraternal knowledge is lost rather than gained in our brotherhood. That is why we must take a more proactive role instead of a reactive role in gaining more members. I am not saying that we start soliciting members; I am saying that we must be more involved with our families, communities, and neighbors so that we can get more people wanting to petition to join our great fraternity.

If we can accomplish this we can be more helpful, stronger, and charitable to our fellow man, there is indeed strength in numbers.

NECROLOGY

We have been truly blessed this year in that the Supreme Grand Master and Architect has left our Grand Line intact; however our hearts weigh heavily with the burden of sadness with the passing our many good Companions, especially our Past Most Illustrious Grand Master Clarence F. ### DISPENSATIONS

Due to my health problems I asked Deputy Grand Master Lloyd Llewellyn to visit the Jackson-Dekalb York Rite Bodies several times and in the interest of time I will submit his last report to me.

"On September 7, 2005 Right Eminent Grand Commander Thomas Craig, Most Excellent Grand High Priest Jimmy O'Dell, Past Grand Master Bobby Terry, Grand Scribe Ray Dunn, Master of the Second Veil Paul Drinkard, Past Grand Commander George Marshall and I, visited Jackson-Dekalb York Rite Bodies.

Notification, written and oral, was issued that we would be visiting. Only five of their members were present. No attempt was made to open the Bodies. We discussed our concerns with those present, but they mostly talked about the Grand Lodge problems rather than those of their York Rite Bodies. The conclusion we reached is that after two years with an arrested charter, we have seen no significant attempt to improve those Bodies.

I do not believe that anything was accomplished at this meeting and my recommendation is that the Charter be arrested and issue demits to the Companions of Dekalb-Jackson Council No. 90."

I am in full agreement with him in this matter it is also my recommendation that this Charter be pulled and demits issued.

I did attend several classes at Woodlawn and the installation of my son, Ron, Jr., as Worshipful Master of Hokes Bluff Lodge #470 and several other Blue Lodge functions. I did however ask R.I. We your audit committee have reviewed the books and records of the Grand Council Royal and Select Masters of Alabama for the period 1 January 2005 through 31 December 2005. We found no discrepancies in the records we reviewed that would lead us to believe that a modification to the financial statements would be warranted. In our review we discovered some areas of the records of the Grand Council that need updating. We have made comments concerning these areas in the Notes to Financial Statements section of this report.

It is common for the Grand Recorder and the Grand Treasurer to change in the same year; it is also common for a full audit to be performed by a qualified firm to be conducted on the records of the preceding officers. While we found nothing that would lead the committee to believe that everything was not in order, no one knows what the future may or may not discover. We the committee commends the current Grand Recorder and Grand Treasurer for accepting the call to serve this Grand Body without a full audit of the records being performed. With this in mind we recommend a motion be put forth absolving the 2006 elected Grand Recorder and Grand Treasurer for any and all acts that may relate to the financial records before they took office.

Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The Grand Council's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

Inventories

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the first-in, first-out method, or market.

\*\*The committee feels that the inventory numbers need updating since we could not find records indicating when the inventory was last updated.

Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

\*\* The committee feels that the depreciation numbers need updating due to the fact that in the last several years of the proceedings these numbers have not changed.

Note 2 - Tax Status

The Grand Council is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501©, and from state income tax under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990.

Note 3 - Restricted Assets

A Triennial Reserve account is established as a reserve to cover expenses for specific officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year there was an increase in the balance of this reserve account to \$ 2,350.00

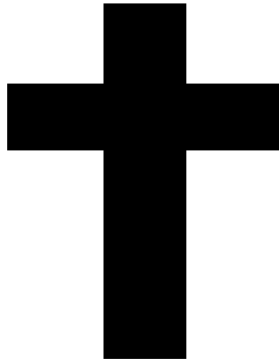



**ALABAMA GRAND YORK RITE HOLDING COMPANY**

*To the Grand Officers and members of the Grand York Rite of Alabama:*

The Holding Company held its annual Meeting on Saturday, March 12, 2005, at the Grand York Rite office in Birmingham in conjunction with a joint meeting of the Vulcan Council No.22, Knight Masons, and the Alabama Priory No.31, KYCH, meeting in the Birmingham Metro York Rite Temple. The only order of business to be conducted was the election of officers for the year 2005 which resulted in the following:

Emory J. Ferguson..... President  
Charles R. Pate.....Vice-President  
Erskine K. Smith.....Vice-President  
Fred W. McCluskey..... Treasurer  
Arthur C. Harding..... Secretary

With the resignations of Most Illustrious Companion Fred W. McCluskey as Grand Treasurer and Right Eminent Sir Knight Arthur C. Harding as Grand Secretary/Recorder, the offices of Treasurer and Secretary are declared vacant and by the Articles of Incorporation of the Alabama Grand York Rite Holding Company, Incorporated, the Companion/Sir Knight who are elected at these sessions of the Grand York Rite of Alabama as the new Grand Treasurer and Grand Recorder of the Grand York Rite Bodies of Alabama will automatically fill those positions.

The March 12<sup>th</sup> meeting was the only one held in 2005 as no business concerning the office space or inventory of the Grand Bodies came before the Company.

The original agreement between the Birmingham York Rite Temple Corporation and The Grand York Rite Bodies of Alabama have been in complete compliance with the terms set down even before the construction of the building began. However, I feel that is is worthwhile to review those original agreements from time to time to refresh our memories as to what our agreements were.

The Grand York Rite Bodies were to assume occupancy of the offices on the completion of the building but would not begin paying rent until February 1, 1999. The agreement also included the use of the men's and ladies rest room facilities, utilities provided by individual heat pump with no separate meter, a separate entrance with 4-6 parking spaces, separate locks to office area making offices inaccessible from the main building, space provided in the corridor for display cases, space provided in the conference room for any overflow from the Grand York Rite library and space provided in the attic for storage.

The amount of rent was set at \$4,500.00 annually payable at \$375.00 monthly for 5 years of which \$3,600.00 annually or \$300.00 monthly would be for the capital recovery of the cost of the addition to the building or \$18,000.00 and the remaining \$900.00 annually or \$75.00 monthly for utilities.

After capital recovery of \$18,000.00 for the cost of the addition to the building the rent was to reduce to, and on February 1, 2004 did reduce to \$3,300.00 annually or \$275.00 monthly of which \$2,400.00 annually or \$200.00 monthly would be for rent and \$900.00 annually

or \$75.00 monthly would be for utilities. Further agreement was that the cost of utilities could be renegotiated at the end of the 5 year period but only to the extent of, and not to exceed, any increase imposed by the utility company or companies. In other words, by agreement, the \$2,400.00 annually or \$200.00 monthly rent can never be increased. Only the cost of Utilities can and those only by proof of increased utility rates.
