DISPENSATIONS

I granted Huntsville Eureka Council #5 and Florence Council #74 permission to confer degrees in Decatur Council #81.

The Last week of March, 2006 Grand Secretary Companion Hiram Williams mailed a Registered letter to the Office of DeKalb-Jackson York Rite Bodies informing them of the decisions of the Grand York

Rite Bodies that DeKalb-Jackson was to merge with Huntsville York Rite Bodies. Most Excellent Grand High Priest Robert Moseson, Grand Commander Teddy Grogan and Most Illustrious Grand Master Lloyd Llewellyn would be there April 3, 2006 at 4:00 P.M. to remove all records, Charters, Monies paraphernalia and any other properties belonging to the DeKalb-Jackson York Rite Bodies.

On April 3, 2006 we arrived at 3:30 P.M. and waited until about 5:00 P.M... The Officers did not show up to meet with us. As we were about to leave at 5:00 P.M. Companion Floyd Hamrick did come, I do not believe that he was there to meet with us and said that he did not receive the letter. Companion David Shirey told him that it was to be on April 30, 2006 nothing at this time was available to us.

Companion Floyd Hamrick asked when would we come back to get the materials and he would have all of it on the front porch of the lodge for us to remove. We informed him that we would be back April 8, 2006 at 10:00 A.M...

On April 8, 2006 Companion Hiram Williams and I once again returned to DeKalb-Jackson at 10:00 A.M. we were able to remove all the paraphernalia, books a storage cabinet and a check for \$5,574.69. These items were loaded on to Companion Hiram Williams's truck and taken to Birmingham Metro. The Charters were missing and they have not been found at this time.

Companion Hamrick later informed me that DeKalb-Jackson York Rite Bodies never had received the Charters. All the above items are now property of Huntsville York Rite Bodies.

Recommendations

I recommend that the Grand Council Constitution and By-Laws be revised to meet today's needs and goals.

I recommend that Council membership attend their Blue Lodges and take active parts in the Lodge, they need to go through the chairs and take a part in the Ritual Work.

Continue to develop a computer program that can be used by all State Councils to make reports and for their membership records

Make the Grand Council financially self sufficient.

AUDIT

I commend this committee of Companion James C. McGee, Companion Jack C. Wade and Companion Robert C. Grigsby for auditing the books and records of the Grand Council.

CONCLUSION

I want to thank the Council membership for the courtesies shown me during this year. Thanks to all the committees for their prompt and efficient attention given to any problems that came up. I would like to thank companion Hiram Williams for his patience with me. I know that I have made mistakes, but I have acted to the best of my judgment. It is hoped that no one has been offended by me and if so, it certainly was not intended.

I say thank you to my wife Mary, who has supported me in many ways, especially for the attention given to the many duties in preparing for this annual assembly. I feel that there is much yet to be done and I pledge to my successor my wholehearted support in the coming year.

Notes to Financial Statements

Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

A. Basis of Accounting

The Grand Council's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

B. Inventories

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the first-in, first-out method, or market.

C. Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

Note 2 - Tax Status

The Grand Council is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501©, and from state income tax under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990.

Note 3 - Restricted Assets

A Triennial Reserve account is established as a reserve to cover expenses for specific officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year there was an increase in the balance of this reserve account to \$ 2,350.00

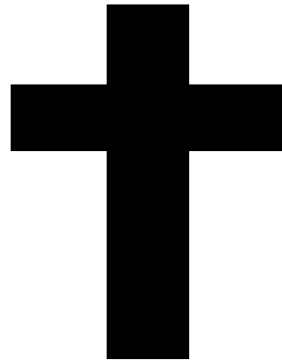

X...On October 1st William C. Havens Renounced Masonry. MacArthur Davis, Deputy Grand Master assumed the duties as Acting Grand Master and Presided over the Annual Assembly on February 23, 2003

Y...On December 31st, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned and Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Grand Recorder.

Z...At the Annual Assembly in February, 2006 Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and Most Illustrious Past Grand Master (honorary). Most Illustrious Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected as Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Recorder.
