Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

A. Basis of Accounting

The Grand Council's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

B. Inventories

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the first-in, first-out method, of market.

C. Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

Note 2 - Tax Status

The Grand Council is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501©, and from state income tax under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990.

Note 3 - Restricted Assets

A Triennial Reserve account is established as a reserve to cover expenses for specific officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year there was an increase in the balance of this reserve account to \$ 1,300.00

**PROPOSITION TO AMED THE CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE GRAND COUNCIL OF ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS OF ALABAMA WHICH EFFECTS THE CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE GRAND CHAPTER OF ROYAL ARCH MASONS OF ALABAMA AND THE GRAND COMMANDERY OF KNIGHTS TEMPLAR OF ALABAMA.**

**December 17, 2009**

Whereas attendance at the Annual Assembly has been steadily decreasing in past years, and whereas holding the Annual Assembly on Monday and Tuesday prevents some Companions who work from attending, and whereas holding the Annual Assembly on the weekend enhances the potential of lower hotel rates, and whereas the current practice of holding a reception and banquet on Sunday already requires most attendees to devote Sunday to travel and participating in these activities, be it therefore adopted that Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Grand Council of Royal & Select Masters of Alabama be amended by changing "Monday" to "Saturday."

ARTICLE III - Assemblies

SECTION 1. The Annual Assembly of this Grand Council shall be held on the last Monday (the word Monday to be deleted) Saturday (the word Saturday to be inserted) in February of each year, at such place as may be selected at the preceding Annual Assembly.

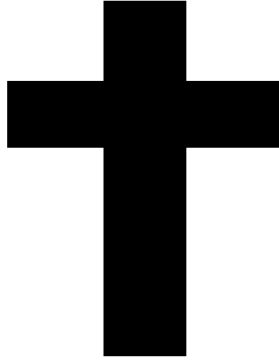


