REPORT OF THE GRAND COMMANDERY BY-LAWS COMMITTEE

To the Right Eminent Grand Commander, Officers, and Members of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Alabama:

We your By-Laws Committee make the following report: During the 2019-2020 York Rite year and since the last Grand York Rite Session, there have been no by-law changes from any of the subordinate commanderies submitted to this committee for review.

We received the following proposed change to Article 1, Section 9 of the Grand Commandery Constitution:

Section to be amended: Article 1, Section 9
ANNUAL CONCLAVE AND ELECTION

Section 9. (a) The Annual Conclave of this Grand Commandery shall be held at such place as a majority vote shall determine, on the last Monday in February of each year, or the Tuesday following the last Monday in February, provided that in case of necessity, of which a majority of the first four officers of the Grand Commandery shall judge exists, the Annual Conclave shall be at such time and/or place as may be determined by the Grand Commander, he having previously secured the consent of a majority of the constituent Commanderies, and in cases involving a change of time and/or place of holding the Annual Conclave, all constituent Commanderies and members of the Grand Commandery shall have at least thirty (30) days' notice, provided by the Grand Recorder.

To be amended to read:

Section 9. (a) The Annual Conclave of this Grand Commandery shall be held at such place as a majority vote shall determine, on the last Friday in February of each year, provided that in case of necessity, of which a majority of the first four officers of the Grand Commandery shall judge exists, the Annual Conclave shall be at such time and/or place as may be determined by the Grand Commander, he having previously secured the consent of a majority of the constituent Commanderies, and in cases involving a change of time and/or place of holding the Annual Conclave, all constituent Commanderies and members of the Grand Commandery shall have at least thirty (30) days' notice, provided by the Grand Recorder.

Reason: Not highlighted by RESK Marshall in the rewrite.

ADOPTED: BY UNANIOUS VOTE

Section to be amended: Article I – Section 3 CONCLAVES

Section 3. (a) Each Commandery shall hold a Conclave at least quarterly, at such time and place as may be specified in the Charter or designated in the By-Laws of the Commandery. (b) Special Conclaves may be called by the Commander, but no business shall be transacted other than the conferring of the Orders, except that specified in the notice or summons. (c) A failure to assemble for twelve (12) successive months shall be deemed sufficient cause for the arrest or forfeiture of its Charter. (d) Failure of a Commandery to knight at least one new Knight per year is likewise sufficient cause for the arrest or forfeiture of its Charter. (e) Nine or more members of a Commandery, entitled to vote therein, including an officer authorized to open the same, shall constitute a quorum. (f) The Grand Commander or a Past Grand Commander may open and/or close a Commandery by declaration in "ample form."

To be amended to read;

Section 3. (a) Each Commandery shall hold a Conclave at least quarterly, at such time and place as may be specified in the Charter or designated in the By-Laws of the Commandery. (b) Special Conclaves may be called by the Commander, but no business shall be transacted other than the conferring of the Orders, except that specified in the notice or summons. (c) A failure to assemble for twelve (12) successive months shall be deemed sufficient cause for the arrest or forfeiture of its Charter. (d) Failure of a Commandery to knight at least one new Knight per year is likewise sufficient cause for the arrest or forfeiture of its Charter. (e) Nine Sir Knights are required to open a Commandery. Five or more members of a Commandery, entitled to vote therein, including an officer authorized to open the same, shall constitute a quorum. (f) The Grand Commander or a Past Grand Commander may open and/or close a Commandery by declaration in "ample form."

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR EYE FOUNDATION 51ST VOLUNTARY CAMPAIGN

To the Grand Commander, Grand Officers and Sir Knights of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Alabama:

I never know how much the Sir Knights have contributed to the annual Voluntary Campaign until I receive the final reports from the Eye Foundation in May. I only know what is received by me at the Grand Conclave when we meet in February. Until that time, I have no idea of the contributions that you Sir Knights make directly to the Eye Foundation during the Year. I do receive a report from the Eye Foundation that begins with the new Voluntary Campaign in June and goes through December 31st each year which gives me a report on how our personal contributions to the Foundation for the First six months of the campaign are progressing. I will give you those numbers at the end of this report.

Our total contributions for the 51st Voluntary Campaign was \$9,852.63. A disappointing \$3,747.87 less than our contributions to the 50th campaign of \$13,600.50. Our Total Dollar Rank was 31st down from 23rd, our Active member Per Capita Average Rank was 38th down from 25th and our Cumulative Total Dollar Rank was 32nd down from 28th, for the 50th campaign.

Once again Huntsville Commandery No. 7 ranked number 1 with \$2,354.33 in total contributions which resulted with an Active Member Per Capita Average of \$28.03 per Sir Knight. Cyrene Commandery No. 10 was ranked second with \$1,876.00 in total contributions and Tuscaloosa Commandery No. 13 ranked 2nd in Active Member Per Capita contributions of \$9.71 per Sir Knight. Mobile Commandery No. 2 was ranked third with \$1,397.10 in total contributions and Montgomery Commandery No. 15 was ranked 3rd in Active Member Per Capita contributions of \$9.07 per Sir Knight. For the 50th campaign nine of our 12 commanderies contributed more than \$10.00 per Sir Knight. In the 51st campaign only Huntsville contributed more than \$10.00 per member.

And, we are off to a pretty good start on the 52nd campaign, better than our start on the 51st campaign last year, with a total contribution of \$4,226.00 compared to \$3,336.00 last year. Etowah Commandery No. 15 is leading the way with total contributions of \$1,150.00, and Huntsville Commandery No. 7 is off to a good start with contributions of \$810.00. Thus far all of our commanderies have individual Sir Knights that have contributed to the campaign with the exception of Monroeville Commandery.

I do not have any numbers on the amount of money earned for the 4th Annual Knights Templar Charity Ball or the Knights Templar Charity Golf Tournament so I cannot include those numbers in this report. I do encourage each of you. However, to support all of our fund-raising activities that support our charities. It is up to each of us to make a difference.

He is a veteran of the United States Air Force serving from 1960 to 1964.

After military service he was employed by the Friden division of the Singer Corporation for 11 years. He retired from the 3M Company as a maintenance supervisor after 26 years of service. Sir Knight Jerry specialized in industrial controls and supervised multi-discipline crews. He managed various projects which included the formation of a metrology laboratory, ISO 9002 certification, as well as planning and scheduling maintenance activities and special projects.

He married Lena Ruth "Sam" Wheeler in 1962. Lena is the daughter of Rev. Joseph L. and Ruth Robinson Wheeler. Sir Knight Jerry and Lena have one son, Sir Knight William J. "Doug" Burfitt, Jr., who is retired from the U.S.A.F. and currently serves as Grand Sword Bearer of the Grand Commandery of Alabama. They have two grandsons, a granddaughter, a great-granddaughter and four great-grandsons. All are residents of Madison County, Alabama.

Sir Knight Jerry is a member of Ford's Chapel United Methodist Church in Harvest, Alabama. He has served on the Church Council and as Treasurer. Other areas of church service include Liturgist, Usher, Council on Ministries, Evangelism Committee, Stewardship Committee, Kitchen Committee, and the United Methodist Men's Club.

Sir Knight Jerry enjoys woodworking as a hobby.

Sir Knight Jerry is a member of Apollo Lodge #921 in Madison County Alabama, as is his son William, Jr. and Grandson Allen. He is a Perpetual Member. He received his Entered Apprentice degree September 5, 1979, was passed to Fellowcraft October 31, 1979 and raised a Master Mason December 5, 1979. He served as Master of Apollo Lodge in 1990-91 and as Lodge secretary for two years.

Sir Knight Jerry is a member of the Huntsville Scottish Rite Bodies. He has served in all four chairs as Venerable Master, Wise Master, Commander and Master of Kadosh. He has served as Director of Work, Treasurer, Commander of the Honor Men's Club and Personal Representative of the Sovereign Grand Inspector General in Alabama (twice). He is currently serving as General Secretary. He was awarded the Rank and Decoration of Knight Commander of the Court of Honor on October 16, 1989; he was Coroneted a 33° on December 11, 1993 and was honored with the Grand Cross of the Court of Honour on August 19, 2017.

He has served as president of the Alabama Scottish Rite Foundation since 2002 and finds helping dyslexic children very rewarding. Under his leadership, the Foundation has added four diagnosticians who test up to 600 children in Alabama for dyslexia annually, all without a fee. In 2019 the Alabama Scottish Rite Foundation was very instrumental in the passing of the Alabama Literacy Act. It was a milestone legislation. He served on the Alabama State Board of Education Teacher Retention Committee.

He assisted in the formation of the Alabama Branch of the International Dyslexia Association and was a member of its first board of directors.

Companion and Sir Knight Jerry received his York Rite degrees and orders in the Huntsville York Rite bodies in 1986, being knighted on September 27, 1986. Foot Notes to Tabular View of the Grand Commandery of Alabama

First Annual Conclave was held in Montgomery, Alabama on Friday November 30, 1860

Grand Commandery office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Recorder in 1962 At the Annual Conclave, April 1963, Earl D. Holmes was elected and installed as Grand Commander, but he died before he could serve.

At the Annual Conclave, April 1973 Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Recorder. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Recorder Emeritus, and the Annual Conclave Date was changed from April each year to the last Monday in February to correspond with Grand Chapter and Grand Council.

As proof of continual effort of Alabama to promote York Rite unity, the first combined meeting of The Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.

On November 1, 1974 the Grand York Rite office was moved to 3621 South Fifth Avenue Birmingham.

In September 1979 the Grand York Rite office was moved to 5504 ½ North First Avenue Birmingham 35212.

On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.

At the Annual Conclave February 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

On September 1, 1981 Thomas W. Mann and James A. Kile resigned as Grand Recorder and Grand Treasurer. Arthur C. Harding was appointed as Grand Recorder and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was appointed Grand Treasurer.

At the Annual Conclave February 1992, Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Recorder and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Treasurer. Thomas W. Mann was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and James A. Kile was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

On June 23 1997, Past Grand Commander Robert L. Byars, Jr., renounced York Rite Masonry and is no longer a member. On January 13, 1999 the Grand York Rite office moved to 3430 Ratliff Road, Irondale, AL 3510

On December 31, 2005, Arthur C. Harding and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., resigned as Grand Recorder and Grand Treasurer, Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Grand Recorder and Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Grand Treasurer.

At the Annual Conclave February 2006, Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Recorder Emeritus and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Hiram O. Williams, Jr., was elected Grand Recorder. Also Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Commander Honorary.

February 24th, 2012 was the beginning of our Annual Meetings being held on the last Friday of February each year. This was presented in February 2010 and laid over until February 2011 on which the vote was taken and passed to meet on the last Friday of February each year.

October 1st, 2013, Sir Knight Arthur Lee Campbell, III Eminent Grand Warder Resigned from Masonry with no reason stated.

CHRONOLOGY

Titles of Meetings and Dates of Bodies Composed Exclusively of Masons.

The ordinary calendar, or vulgar era, is not generally used by Freemasons in dating their official documents. They have one peculiar to themselves, differing according to their various Rites.

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS in all parts of the world, add 4,000 years to the Christian era, calling it Anno Lucis-Year of Light; abbreviated A.L. (This fact has a symbolic reference, not because they believe Freemasonry is, but that the principles and light of the institution are coeval with the creation. (See below.) F&AM Lodges hold "Communications."

<u>ROYAL ARCH MASONS</u> date from the building of the second Temple-530 B.C. Their style is, therefore, *Anno Inventionis*-A. Inv. - in the year of the discovery. Royal Arch Chapters hold "Convocations."

<u>ROYAL AND SELECT MASONS</u> date from the completion of Solomon's Temple 1000 B.C. Their style is *Anno Depositionis*-A. Dep.-in the year of Deposit. Royal and Select Councils hold "Assemblies."

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR date from the organization of the Order in 1118 A.D. Their style is, therefore, *Anno Ordinis*-A.O.-in the year of the Order. Knight Templar Commanderies hold "Conclaves."

ORDER OF THE HIGH PRIESTHOOD dates from the blessing of Abraham by the High Priest Melchizedek, which occurred 1914 B.C. Their style is *Anno Benedistionis*-A.B.-in the year of the Blessing. Councils of Anointed High Priest hold "Convocations."

<u>ANCIENT AND ACCEPTED SCOTTISH RITE MASONS</u> use the Jewish Calendar, which adds 3760 to the Christian era, styled *Anno Mundi-A.M.*-year of the World. Or, they sometimes use the Hebrew year which begins on the seventeenth of September or feast of Tisri, using the initials A.H.-*Anno Hebraico*.

<u>TEMPLES, A.A.O.N. MYSTIC SHRINE</u>; Each thirty years from the Hejira, or July 15th, A.D. 602 constitutes a cycle. Nineteen of these years contain 355 days, Eleven, 356.

RULES FOR MASONIC DATES

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS - Add 4,000 years.

Thus: $2020 + 4{,}000 = A.L. 6020$

ROYAL ARCH MASONS - Add 530 years.

Thus: 2020 + 530 = A. Inv. 2550

ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS - Add 1,000 years.

Thus: 2020 + 1,000 years = A. Dep. 3020

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR - Subtract 1,118 years.

Thus: $2020 - 1{,}118 = A.O.902$

ORDER OF HIGH PRIESTHOOD - Add 1,913 years.

Thus: 2020 + 1,913 = A.B. 3,933

SCOTTISH RITE MASONS - Add 3,760 years.

Thus: 2020 + 3,760 = A.M. 5780
