Address of Right Eminent Grand Commander

WILLIAM J. BURFITT 2020-2021

To the Officers, Past Grand Commanders, Sir Knights and Distinguished Guests of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Alabama:

It is my pleasure and distinct honor to welcome each of you to our One Hundred Sixty First Annual Conclave of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Alabama. Thank you for being here. This is not only a time to conduct the business of the Grand Commandery, but to renew old friendships and to make new ones.

To our out of state and other distinguished Sir Knights, many of whom have traveled many miles to be here, I likewise extend to you a warm and fraternal welcome to the great state of Alabama. I hope that your visit among us will be most enjoyable. If I personally, or any of the Grand Commandery Officers, can do anything to serve you while you are with us, please, do not hesitate to ask.

STATE OF THE CRAFT

As with any Grand Presiding Officer's report on the State of the Craft, there are good things to report and bad things to report.

First, some of the bad, as you probably expect, our Grand Recorder's Report will once again show a loss in membership. So, the trend in declining membership continues. Will it stop? I can't say for sure, but I hope that it will. The Corona pandemic has wreaked havoc on our society and our fraternity.

On a more positive note, the transition in the offices of Grand Secretary-Recorder and Grand Treasurer could not have gone any smoother. Once again, I would like to thank Ed Mason, Hiram and Cindy Williams for their dedicated and devoted service. Sir Knights, I believe we are fortunate that Sir Knight Thomas Nesbitt and Sir Knight James McGee were willing to take their places. They are indeed dedicated servants of the Craft!

NECROLOGY

During this past year, our Grand Commandery line of officers was untouched by the Grim reaper. However, the Grand Commandery did have some losses which you will hear in our Grand prelate's report. We offer our deepest sympathies to the families of these and other Sir Knights that we lost this year. Our Grand prelate will have more fitting remarks in his report.

DISPENSATIONS GRANTED

I granted dispensation to Huntsville Commandery #7 to hold an email election of Commandery Officers.

On July 4, 2020 I granted dispensation for Lee Commandery #45 to elect their Commandery Officers by telephone.

OTHER ACTIONS

On May 4, 2020 Grand Master Jeffery Nelson, MEGM, released General Order Number 12. In this order GM Nelson says (and I quote: "It is ordered that all in-person Conclaves of Grand, Constituent, or Subordinate Commandries be prohibited until further notice.

Any such Conclave <u>currently scheduled</u> is hereby cancelled. This prohibition has no exceptions."

With those words, **G.M. Nelson cancelled our <u>scheduled</u> Grand Commandery.**

So under General Order No. 12 and many other restrictions the question of when we might convene a Grand Conclave or even if we might do so was very real.

We were under a signed contract with the DoubleTree Hotel which carried very real financial consequences to the Grand Commandery if we did not meet the terms of that obligation.

The Grand High Priest, The Grand Illustrious Master and I all felt it prudent to see if we might withdraw from the contract with the DoubleTree. The DoubleTree, however, was reluctant to terminate the contract but offered an amended contract for 2022. The Grand Officers felt this was a good and fair offer. After consulting with the next officer in the chains of command, they concurred – and we accepted the amended contract.

What the Corona virus would mean to our future, we needed an alternate plan for the 2021 Grand York Rite meeting (knowing that the Grand Commandery might not participate). The Grand High Priest, the Grand Illustrious Master and I felt that Birmingham Metro could meet our needs with a lot of adjustments. Birmingham Metro agreed. So with a great deal of work from our Grand Secretaries, provisional plans were made.

On November 1, General Order 14 was issued and I felt that the Grand Commandery Conclave would be possible.

I offer much gratitude to the Grand Secretaries, both SK McGee and SK Williams, for all their hard work to make this happen.

After looking into the irregularities pertaining to the reinstatement of Sir Knight Branson Heath Fant, the Grand High Priest, Grand Illustrious Master and myself investigated the situation. I (we) found that so many errors had been committed that the proper action was to order him healed and restored. So on May 23, 2020 I ordered S.K. Fant restored to membership in Cyrene Commandery #10. I wish to thank SK Cooley and SK Andress for their consultation and concurrence in this matter.

On May 23, Sir Knight Ed Mason resigned his position as Grand Treasurer due to health reasons. I appointed Sir Knight Thomas Nesbit, Past Grand Commander, as Treasurer of the Grand Commandery of Alabama.

At the Officer's retreat May the 23rd. Sir Knight Hiram submitted his resignation as Grand Recorder, effective October 1, 2020. I appointed Sir Knight James McGee, Past Grand Commander and Southeastern Department Commander, Grand Recorder effective October 1, 2020.

REVIEW OF BOOKS

I granted permission to the Grand Secretary to turn over the books to the Audit Committee for their review. I wish to thank the committee for their efforts.

IN AND OUT OF STATE VISITS

Sir Knights, my visitations were greatly curtailed by the corona virus pandemic. However, following the guidelines and restrictions that were in place I did manage some. On March 2, Lena and I travel to South Carolina. This was to be our last out of state visit. Their hospitality was outstanding.

I attended the Grand Officer's retreat. This is a very informative for all of the Grand York Rite Officers and I hope it continues.

As situations allowed, I visited several Commandery and other functions within Alabama.

RECOMMENDATIONS/SUGGESTIONS

Sir Knights, The Coronal virus has done a great deal of damage to our Lodges, Chapters, Councils and Commanderies. I fear that many might get out of the habit of attending regularly or might have found other things to do. We have much work to do in our futures.

It is imperative that we as York Rite Masons maintain a close tie with our members. When the pandemic ends, we must make every effort to get our members to resume attendance. Call them, talk to them at Blue Lodge, send them a letter, whatever, but make a concerted effort to get them back!

Not only were you outstanding Grand Officers, but you are really good people as well. I sincerely enjoyed our times together.

Special thanks go to our Grand Recorders, Hiram Williams and James McGee. Thank you, Hiram and Jim for the outstanding job you do.

Report of the Committee on Knights Templar Eye Foundation 52nd Voluntary Campaign

To the Grand Commander, Officers and Sir Knights of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Alabama:

Sir Knights: Alabama's contributions to the Eye Foundation for the 51^{st} Campaign was a disappointing decrease in contributions from \$13,600.50 for the 50^{th} Campaign to \$9,852.63 for the 51^{st} Campaign and the Total Dollar Rank had decreased from 23rd to 31^{st} , the Active Member Per Capita Average Rank had decreased from 25^{th} to 38^{th} and the Cumulative Total Dollar Rank had decreased from 28^{th} to 32^{nd} .

The good news is, Sir Knights is, that Alabama's contributions increased from \$9,852.63 for the 51st Campaign to \$16,220.66 for the 52nd Campaign and the Total Dollar Rank increased from 31 to 22, the Active Member Per Capita Average Rank increased from 38th to 27th and the Cumulative Total Dollar Amount increased from 32nd to 19th. What an improvement and you Sir Knights are to be commended for your generosity in giving to such a great cause.

Of our thirteen Commanderies we had eight that contributed \$10.00, or more: Huntsville No. 7 (\$46.02 per member), DeMolay No.14 (22.63 per member), Etowah No. 15 (\$20.45 per member), Florence No. 39 (\$19.17 per member), Anniston No. 23 (\$18.42 per member), Dothan No. 25 (\$15.42 per member), Montgomery No. 4 (\$11.48 per member) and Tuscaloosa No.13 (\$11.06 per member).

We had two Commanderies that contributed \$5.00, or more: Lee No. 45 (\$6.98 per member) and Cyrene No. 10 (\$6.76 per member).

As I have told you before. Usually, I only know the amount of contributions that you present to me at our Grand Assembly yearly to be forwarded to the Eye Foundation but I am seldom notified of any personal contributions that you, as individuals, make to the Eye Foundations. The only other source of information that I have for contributions that you may make is the Knights Templar Magazine for contributions made to the Grand Commanders Club or the Grand Masters Club. I do not know the final contributions until I receive the Final Report from the Eye Foundation.

Freemasonry is known for it's generosity in giving to charitable causes but as we decrease in membership it means that those of us who are still faithful must open the purse strings and dig a little deeper to maintain that reputation. As Sir Knight James "JIM" Wall said frequently, "Don't give until it hurts; give until it feels good."

Sir Knight Winston and Jean had one son, Lewis, who died in November 1998 and a daughter, Tricia. He has two grandchildren: Patrick, who is working part time at Briarwood Christian School, and Reagan, who is a Junior at Mississippi State.

Sir Knight Winston is a member of Huffman Baptist Church in Huffman, Alabama. He has served his church family as a Royal Ambassador leader for 10 years and as Deacon for 9 years.

Foot Notes to Tabular View of the Grand Commandery of Alabama

First Annual Conclave was held in Montgomery, Alabama on Friday November 30, 1860 Grand Commandery office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Recorder in 1962

At the Annual Conclave, April 1963, Earl D. Holmes was elected and installed as Grand Commander, but he died before he could serve.

At the Annual Conclave, April 1973 Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Recorder. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Recorder Emeritus, and the Annual Conclave Date was changed from April each year to the last Monday in February to correspond with Grand Chapter and Grand Council.

As proof of continual effort of Alabama to promote York Rite unity, the first combined meeting of The Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.

On November 1, 1974 the Grand York Rite office was moved to 3621 South Fifth Avenue Birmingham.

In September 1979 the Grand York Rite office was moved to 5504 ½ North First Avenue Birmingham 35212.

On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.

At the Annual Conclave February 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

On September 1, 1981 Thomas W. Mann and James A. Kile resigned as Grand Recorder and Grand Treasurer. Arthur C. Harding was appointed as Grand Recorder and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was appointed Grand Treasurer. At the Annual Conclave February 1992, Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Recorder and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Treasurer. Thomas W. Mann was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and James A. Kile was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

On June 23 1997, Past Grand Commander Robert L. Byars, Jr., renounced York Rite Masonry and is no longer a member.

On January 13, 1999 the Grand York Rite office moved to 3430 Ratliff Road, Irondale, AL 3510

On December 31, 2005, Arthur C. Harding and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., resigned as Grand Recorder and Grand Treasurer, Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Grand Recorder and Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Grand Treasurer.

At the Annual Conclave February 2006, Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Recorder Emeritus and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Hiram O. Williams, Jr., was elected Grand Recorder. Also Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Commander Honorary.

February 24th, 2012 was the beginning of our Annual Meetings being held on the last Friday of February each year. This was presented in February 2010 and laid over until February 2011 on which the vote was taken and passed to meet on the last Friday of February each year.

October 1st, 2013, Sir Knight Arthur Lee Campbell, III Eminent Grand Warder Resigned from Masonry with no reason stated.

On May 23, 2020 Ed Mason resigned as Grand Treasurer. Thomas H Nesbit was appointed Grand Treasurer. On October 1, 2020 Hiram O. Williams resigned as Grand Recorder. James C. McGee was appointed as Grand Recorder. At the Annual Conclave February 2021 James C. McGee was elected Grand Recorder and Thomas H Nesbit, was elected Grand Treasurer. Hiram O. Williams was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and Ed Mason was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

On January 15, 2021 Eminent Grand Generalissimo Thomas Lott resigned his position in the advancing line.

CHRONOLOGY

Titles of Meetings and Dates of Bodies Composed Exclusively of Masons.

The ordinary calendar, or vulgar era, is not generally used by Freemasons in dating their official documents. They have one peculiar to themselves, differing according to their various Rites.

<u>ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS</u> in all parts of the world, add 4,000 years to the Christian era, calling it *Anno Lucis*-Year of Light; abbreviated A.L. (This fact has a symbolic reference, not because they believe Freemasonry is, but that the principles and light of the institution are coeval with the creation. (*See below*.) F&AM Lodges hold "Communications."

<u>ROYAL ARCH MASONS</u> date from the building of the second Temple-530 B.C. Their style is, therefore, *Anno Inventionis*-A. Inv. - in the year of the discovery. Royal Arch Chapters hold "Convocations."

ROYAL AND SELECT MASONS date from the completion of Solomon's Temple 1000 B.C. Their style is *Anno Depositionis*-A. Dep.-in the year of Deposit. Royal and Select Councils hold "Assemblies."

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR date from the organization of the Order in 1118 A.D. Their style is, therefore, *Anno Ordinis*-A.O.-in the year of the Order. Knight Templar Commanderies hold "Conclaves."

ORDER OF THE HIGH PRIESTHOOD dates from the blessing of Abraham by the High Priest Melchizedek, which occurred 1914 B.C. Their style is *Anno Benedistionis*-A.B.-in the year of the Blessing. Councils of Anointed High Priest hold "Convocations."

<u>ANCIENT AND ACCEPTED SCOTTISH RITE MASONS</u> use the Jewish Calendar, which adds 3760 to the Christian era, styled *Anno Mundi-*A.M.-year of the World. Or, they sometimes use the Hebrew year which begins on the seventeenth of September or feast of Tisri, using the initials A.H.-*Anno Hebraico*.

<u>TEMPLES, A.A.O.N. MYSTIC SHRINE;</u> Each thirty years from the Hejira, or July 15th, A.D. 602 constitutes a cycle. Nineteen of these years contain 355 days, Eleven, 356.

RULES FOR MASONIC DATES

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS - Add 4,000 years.

Thus: 2020 + 4,000 = A.L. 6020

ROYAL ARCH MASONS - Add 530 years.

Thus: 2020 + 530 = A. Inv. 2550

ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS - Add 1,000 years.

Thus: 2020 +1,000 years = A. Dep. 3020

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR - Subtract 1,118 years.

Thus: 2020 - 1,118 = A.O. 902

ORDER OF HIGH PRIESTHOOD - Add 1,913 years.

Thus: 2020 + 1,913 = A.B. 3,933

SCOTTISH RITE MASONS - Add 3,760 years.

Thus: 2020 + 3,760 = A.M. 5780
