**ADDRESS OF MOST EXCELLENT GRAND HIGH
PRIEST**

To the Officers, Past Grand High Priests, Companions, and Distinguished Guests of the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Alabama:

Greetings: It is my pleasure to welcome each of you to our One Hundred Seventy-Fifth Annual Convocation of the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Alabama.

As your Grand High Priest, I am humbled to stand here before such a group of distinguished Companions and extend this welcome to you. To our Guests from other States, We hope that your stay will be an enjoyable one and when this meeting is concluded and we say "Ya'll come back - now" you will truly want to come back to visit with us again. The Grand Chapter Officers are here to serve you, so if we can be of assistance to you during your stay, just let us know.

We can not open and conduct the business of this Grand Chapter, without first acknowledging the Tragedy of September 11, 2001. The loss of innocent lives in New York, Washington and Pennsylvania touched the lives of us all, but, indeed this national tragedy made us a greater nation, a better people and gave us compassion for the families who suffered a personal loss. It rekindled our support for those who serve and protect us at home and our military who have gone forth to rid the world of terrorism.

No doubt, there were members of our fraternity who lost their lives as well as good men who would have become members. But the loss of a "beggar in the street" would have been more than we should tolerate under these circumstances. Pray that our resolve will not weaken, that our patriotism will always remain at its highest peak and that we will never tire of doing good. GOD BLESS AMERICA!!

STATE OF THE CRAFT

This is the hardest part of this entire report for me. I have watched the decline in membership for several years and I did not have the courage to go back far enough to see when we last had an overall gain in our membership. Every possible encouragement has been given by those who filled this post before me. Every plea to work, every possible plan has been attempted and our numbers continue to decline.

I am not one of those who believe that Freemasonry will die at the death of our sons and grandsons, but I will say that an evolution is in progress in our fraternity that will eventually change the face of Masonry completely from the way we have known it. This evolution has been brought about by many things beyond our control, but a few things have been aided by our failure to act in a timely manner. Our own reluctance to change anything in Masonry has caused and will continue to cause us much grief and loss over the next twenty five years. By that time the new face of Masonry will have established goals and purposes for its own existence that will give it new life and very few of us will be

around to say "you can't do it that way" OR "we haven't done it that way before".

The one thing that will bring change or the new face to Masonry more than anything else will be economics. The loss of membership is also a loss in revenue. This will have to be dealt with by those that follow us. While we will be known in the York Rite as a conservative people, let us not starve ourselves and our future by being afraid to step out and try new things, even though they may cost money.

As your Grand High Priest, I hope that I have served you well. I attended all of the Southeastern States Grand Conclaves except for Virginia. I have met many great Masons and was treated with the greatest of respect on every trip. Everywhere I went, I found some of the same problems and many of the same rewards.

I traveled to each of the subordinate Chapters in Alabama. All but one held regular meetings. I found most to be doing exceptionally well. I was impressed by many of the Chapters in North Alabama where York Rite Masonry seems to be the strongest. Several of the Chapters in conjunction with the other Bodies, have found success in Community involvement. This would improve all of our Bodies to follow their example. Many are working to keep their membership up and I found some Chapters that are just holding on. I say to them, keep holding on, things will improve for those who are consistent in their efforts.

If I had the key to Freemasonry's success, I would gladly share it with each of you. But now I will share what I have; establish habits of opening and closing the different Bodies at each meeting, start having slow classes, this gives everyone an opportunity to get involved in the degree work. Work as a group in your community to meet the needs of your neighbors and those that have suffered loss through natural disasters and accidents. Also, remember your Brethren, man need rides to the Doctor, to go shopping or just to have someone to talk to. As our age increases so do our needs of support.

As I have said to most of you during my visits with your Chapters: "You are the Choir", that is always there. The ones who do the work from degrees to dish washing, from visiting the sick to attending funerals. You are the ones that keep our doors open, don't stop, don't give up, just keep encouraging others.

NECROLOGY

This year, like so many others, we have lost many Companions across the State, who have gone on to their reward. Our Grand Chaplain will make a more complete report later in this program. And a moment of silent prayer will be observed for the families of those departed Companions. Let us keep each of them in our prayers, thoughts words and deeds.

VISITATIONS

It has been a most enjoyable year visiting the other Southeastern States Grand Convocations. For the Grand Chapter Officers in line, you can and will pick up many good ideas as you travel and see how

the other Grand Bodies attend to their business and conduct their programs.



NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
DECEMBER 31, 2001

NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

A. Basis of Accounting

The organization's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned, and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present financial position and results of operations in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles.

B. Inventories

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the first-in, first-out method, or market.

C. Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

NOTE 2 - TAX STATUS :

The Chapter is exempt from federal income taxes under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c), and from state income taxes under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An informational return is filed each year on IRS Form 990.

NOTE 3 - TEMPORARILY RESTRICTED NET ASSETS:

Temporarily restricted net assets are reserved to cover expenses for specified officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year an additional \$525.00 was designated as a transfer from unrestricted net assets to temporarily restricted net assets, increasing the temporarily restricted assets from \$1,425.00 to \$1,950.00.

Well Companions, I have some good news and I have some bad news. The good news is that we have managed to stay in the top 20 states in contributions to the Royal Arch Research Assistance for one more year. I remind you again that in 1993 we were number 1 in the standings and now we are in 19th place. We have allowed 5 of the 6 other Southeastern states that belong to the General Grand Chapter to pass us in contributions. The only state that has not is Mississippi.

The bad news is that we donated \$662.72 less in 2001 than we did in 2000.

Last year we had regular donations of \$2,040.25 and no memorial donations. The Ladies Craft Room donated \$387.25. No single Chapter in this state has exceeded, or even matched, the contributions made by the Ladies Craft Room. The Order of High Priesthood donated \$100.00, Vulcan Council No. 22, Knight Masons, donated \$100.00 and we had individual donations of \$82.00. The total contributions for 15 Chapters was \$1,371.00; an average of \$91.40 per Chapter.

We had 4 Chapters that received 100% certificates: Piedmont, Decatur, Eunomia and Anniston. There were 6 of the 15 Chapters that made no donation.

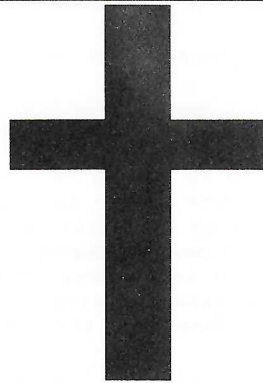

REVISED AND CORRECTED LIST OF GRAND OFFICERS OF THE GRAND CHAPTER OF ALABAMA SINCE ITS ORGANIZATION IN 1823 TO THE PRESENT TIME, WITH THE YEAR OF THEIR ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT.

- a.....May, 1823: A small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- b.....January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- c.....June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore re-organized in June, 1827, and a new constitution adopted.
- d.....December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- e.....July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- f.....No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14th, until the next evening; but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- g.....There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocations fixed for December.
- h.....In 1825 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
- i.....At the Annual Convocation in December, 1844, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
- j.....At Annual Convocation in 1846, on account of ill health, Companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
- k.....On August 4, 1847, following the death of Companion Guy t. Smith, Companion W. E. Glazner was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- l.....At the Annual Convocation, November, 1847, Companion Chas. H. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary.
- m.....At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1856, Companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers.
- n.....On June 27, 1860, following sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- o.....On September 16, 1860 following resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
- p.....On December 1, 1860, Companion Varna A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Evatt, who had resigned.
- q.....Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
- r.....At Annual Convocation, February, 1873, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
- s.....Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
- t.....As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1874.
- u.....On November 1, 1874, the Grand York Rite Office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5th Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
- v.....On October 1, 1879, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
- w.....On May 16, 1860, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
- x.....At Annual Convocation, February, 1881, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
- y.....On September 1, 1891, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
- z.....At the Annual Convocation in February, 1892 Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Past Grand High Priest (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary.

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
