Also sometimes referred to as the Peanut Capital of the World, Home of the National Peanut Festival.

To our Guests from other Grand Jurisdictions, we welcome you. We extend to you our assistance and services that your stay may be most enjoyable.

To the Grand Officers, Companions and Representatives of the 15 subordinate Chapters of Alabama, thank you for attending your Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter. With due respect, I trust you will be attentive to the business at hand.

I have reviewed the accompanying statement of financial position - cash basis of the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Alabama (a non-profit organization) as of December 31, 2004 and the related statement of activities - cash basis for the year then ended, in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. All information included in these financial statements is the representation of the management of the Chapter.

A review consists principally of inquiries of personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data. It is substantially less in scope than an audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, the objective of which is the expression of an opinion regarding the financial statements taken as a whole. Such information has been subjected to the inquiry and analytical procedures applied in the review of the basic financial statements. This information is presented on the cash basis of accounting, and I am not aware of any material modifications that should be made thereto.

NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

A. Basis of Accounting

The organization's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned, and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present financial position and results of operations in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles.

B. Inventories

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the first-in, first-out method, or market.

C. Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

NOTE 2 - TAX STATUS :

The Chapter is exempt from federal income taxes under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c), and from state income taxes under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An informational return is filed each year on IRS Form 990.

NOTE 3 - TEMPORARILY RESTRICTED NET ASSETS:

Temporarily restricted net assets are reserved to cover expenses for specified officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year there were no increases or decreases in this reserve account and the balance remained at \$2,475.00.

RESOLUTION

PROPOSITION TO AMEND THE BY-LAWS OF THE MOST EXCELLENT GRAND ROYAL ARCH CHAPTER OF THE STATE OF ALABAMA

WHEARAS, Article III of the By-Laws now allows for member ship in only one Chapter within this jurisdiction and
WHEARAS, there are members within the jurisdiction that desire to hold dual membership in other subordinate Chapter within this jurisdiction and in the interest of allowing individuals to contribute more to the good of our subordinate Chapters, therefore
BE IT RESOLVED, That Article III be amended as follows:

DELETE THE FOLLOWING SENTENCES TITLED DUAL MEMBERSHIP: A Companion can be a member of only one Chapter in this Jurisdiction but is

permissible for a Companion in this Jurisdiction to hold membership in another Grand Jurisdiction, provided said other Grand Jurisdiction is in fraternal relations with this Grand Jurisdiction, and further provided that said other Grand Jurisdiction legalizes dual membership. Likewise, a Companion of another Grand Jurisdiction that qualifies as above who properly applies and is duly elected can become a dual member of a subordinate Chapter of this Grand Jurisdiction with all rights and obligations of regular membership. Dual membership may continue as long as the Companion remains in good standing in his basic (HOME) Chapter; however, any matter affecting the basic membership will also affect the dual membership.

AND REPLACE THEM WITH THE FOLLOWING:

DUAL MEMBERSHIP:

Section 1a: A Companion can be a member of two Chapter in this Grand Jurisdiction provided both Chapters record him as a dual member, and his membership is reported to the Grand Chapter. However, a dual member cannot hold elected office in both Chapters at the same time. Any matter that affects membership in either Chapter will likewise affect membership in both Chapters. Furthermore, it is permissible for a Companion in this Jurisdiction to hold membership in another Grand Jurisdiction and further provided that said other Grand Jurisdiction legalizes dual membership. Likewise, a Companion of another Grand Jurisdiction that qualifies as above who properly applies and is duly elected can become a dual member of a subordinate Chapter in this Grand Jurisdiction with all rights and obligation of regular membership.

Should a Companion holding dual membership within Alabama desire to withdraw his membership from on Chapter, he shall notify the Chapter from which he desires to withdraw his membership of his decision in writing and if he has paid current dues and no charges are pending against him, the Secretary of the Chapter will carry him as withdrawn and notify the other Chapter in which dual membership was held of the date that the member is no longer a dual member. A Companion holding membership in Alabama and another Grand Jurisdiction may continue as long as the Companion remains in good standing in his basic (HOME) Chapter; however, any matter affection the basic membership will also affect the dual membership.

REPORT OF COMMITTEE FOR RESEARCH ASSISTANCE

*To the Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Grand Officers, and
Companions of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Alabama:*

Lots of new things are happening with the Royal Arch Research Assistance right now. We now have a new partner in the place of Colorado State University.

Because of some major changes in personnel at the University and because that new personnel has some different ideas about how our contributions to the University should be distributed the Board of Directors, of which I am a member, for the Royal Arch Research Assistance decided that our money could be better used elsewhere. In the past the money contributed to the University has always been designated for research in Central Auditory Processing Disorders or for new equipment specified for use in that research but the new heads of the University have decided that the University should have 43% of our contributions for administrative costs.

On January 17, 2005 Dr. Joan Burleigh retired from the Colorado State University leaving the Research Department without expertise to continue the research in Central Auditory Processing Disorders and the University could not, or would not, give the RAFA Board of Directors a satisfactory answer as to whether or not the University planned to continue the research that RARA has supported for 30 years. The really big insult came when the new Dean made the comment that the 1.8 million dollars that RARA has contributed to the University was nothing.

Before retiring from the University Dr. Burleigh and 5 others founded a new company named AblePlanet which is marketing components for hearing devices and is a for profit company. These same founders have also established Able Kids Foundation which is a not for profit foundation for research in Central Auditory Processing Disorders.

Dr. Burleigh will head up this foundation so that she might continue her research.

On January 27th and 28th the RARA Board of Directors met in Nashville, Tennessee, along with Dr. Joan Burleigh and Mr. Tom Hoogendyk, Chief Financial Officer for AblePlanet, Inc., to allow Dr. Burleigh and Mr. Hoogendyk the opportunity to discuss the future of the Able Kids Foundation and the possibility a partnership with the RARA. After many hours of questions and answers with Dr. Burleigh and Mr. Hoogendyk the Board met in closed session to discuss the course that the RARA should take.

Because of the very close working relationship the RARA has had with Dr. Burleigh and because of the confidence and esteem that the Board has for her, it was decided that the RARA would enter into an agreement with the Able Kids Foundation to assist in the funding of this very worthwhile research.

At the present time Dr. Burleigh has a 6 month backlog of evaluations to perform which she has taken with her to the new Foundation and she receives about 40 calls a day for new evaluations so her work continues.

Now if you are interested in what you are doing to help these many kids from almost every state, and some foreign countries obtain a better quality of life, you Companions contributed \$2,302.00 last year to RARA. We had 4 of 15 Chapters that were 100% in giving, that is, contributing at least \$1.00 per member and those Chapters were Anniston No. 105, Eunimia No. #4, Monroeville No. 170 and Mobile #21. We had 6 Chapter that made no contributions at all and these were Tuscaloosa No. 1, Coosa No. 86, DeKalb-Jackson No. 107, Piedmont No. 111, Dothan No. 113 and Phenix City No. 149.

Companions we boast to non-masons about how much we do for charity but 75% of the money that is contributed every year toward charity is given by the smallest number of masons and those are the Shriners. We as York Rite Masons really do need to do better towards the charities that we support. However, RARA does thank you for what you do give and we understand that everyone is trying to get in your billfold for their cause but \$1.00 per member per year is really not too much to ask.

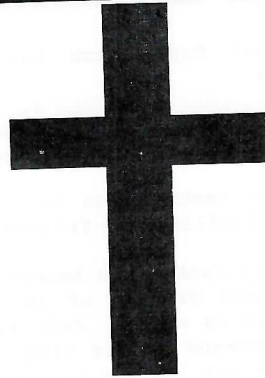

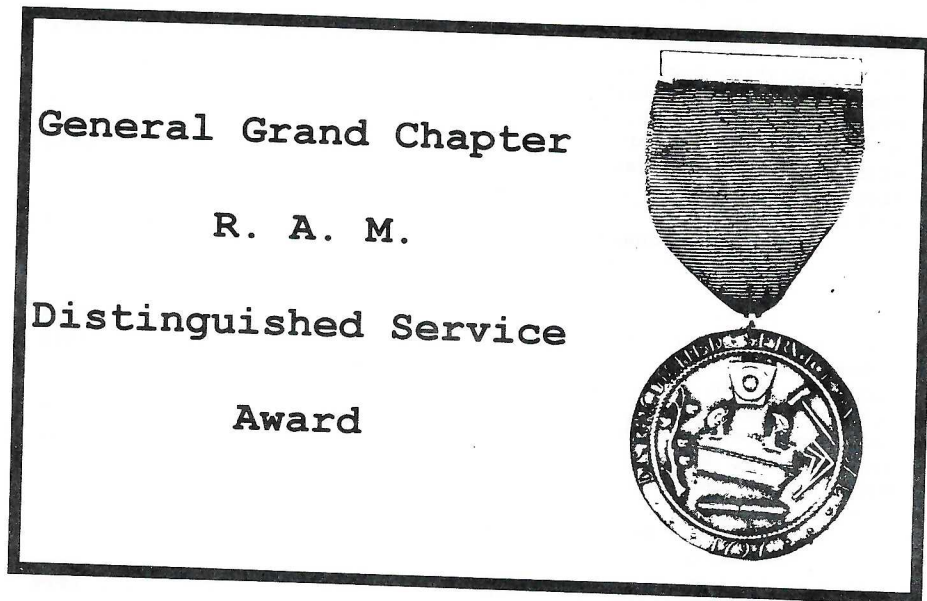

After prayer this Grand Chapter was declared at refreshment for the purpose of open installation of the Grand Officers at 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday morning.

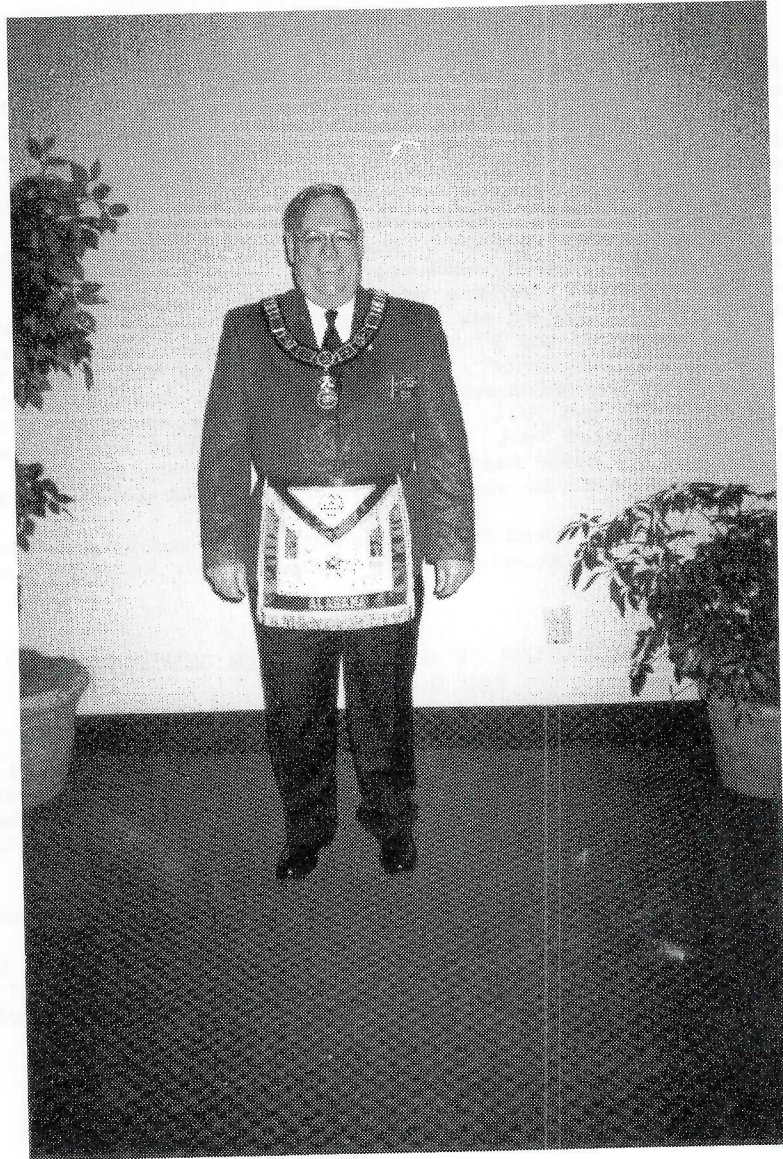
INSTALLATION OF GRAND CHAPTER OFFICERS

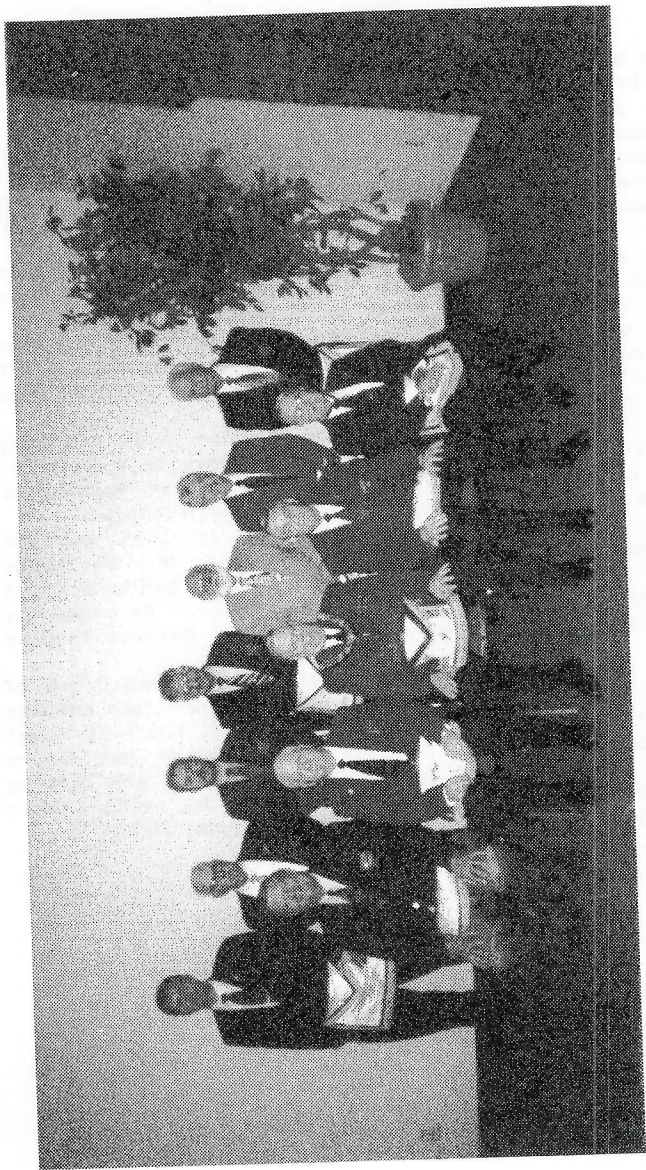

- a. May, 1823: A small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- b. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- c. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore re-organized in June, 1827, and a new constitution adopted.
- d. December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- e. July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- f. No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14th, until the next evening; but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- g. There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocations fixed for December.
- h. In 1825 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
- i. At the Annual Convocation in December, 1944, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
- j. At Annual Convocation in 1946, on account of ill health, Companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
- k. On August 4, 1947, following the death of Companion Guy t. Smith, Companion W. E. Glazner was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- l. At the Annual Convocation, November, 1947, Companion Chas. H. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary.
- m. At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1956, Companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers.
- n. On June 27, 1960, following sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- o. On September 16, 1960 following resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Ewatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
- p. On December 1, 1960, Companion Varma A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Ewatt, who had resigned.
- q. Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
- r. At Annual Convocation, February, 1973, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
- s. Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
- t. As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.
- u. On November 1, 1974, the Grand York Rite Office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5th Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
- v. On October 1, 1979, the Grand York Rite Office was moved to a new location at 5504 1/2 North 1st Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.
- w. On May 16, 1960, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
- x. At Annual Convocation, February, 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
- y. On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
