## ADDRESS OF THE MOST ILLUSTRIOUS GRAND MASTER SIDNEY R. COOLEY SR. 2020-2021

To the Past Illustrious Grand Masters, Officers, Companions, and Distinguished Guests of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama:

Welcome to the 183rd annual Assembly of the Grand Council of Alabama, R. & S.M. As we pick ourselves up, dust ourselves off, put on our aprons and return to our labors for our Craft, CV19 cannot and will not hold us down.

To our visiting distinguished guests, "Welcome to Sweet Home Alabama". We extend our hospitality to each of you and thank you for all the warm and wonderful hospitality you and all the Companions of your Grand Jurisdictions always show us. Due to CV19 we were not able to visit as we have in past years, and we are looking forward to seeing and visiting with you soon. Thank you all for being here.

#### STATE OF THE ORDER

Councils of Alabama have this year possibly more so than past years faced a challenge to our Masonic Lodges other than the ones we normally face, and I think this has happened in other jurisdictions also. Aging membership, declining membership, higher costs, not to mention the competition from other pursuits for those who we wish to have joined. This makes it extremely difficult to recruit for some of our Councils. However during my travels this year, I observed that our several Councils are still laboring at maintaining our rituals and forms as hard as it may be we have to continue to strive at our labors to continue. I would like to commend those York Rite Masons who have toiled in our communities to make others aware of many Masonic Bodies promoting CMMRF who is making great strides in the Heart and Diabetes treatments that are being improved all the time. I also wish thank Companion Joel Bryant for all his hard work in organizing and doing the Chapter and Council degrees event at Gadsden this year. Thanks to Companions Mike Feld (Eureka Council) and Joel Bryant (Gadsden Council) for all their hard work on our new Council Guide. I encourage all to step up not sit on the side lines.

#### **NECROLOGY**

In his infinite Mercy and Wisdom God has left our Grand Council unbroken this year. We are however very saddened at the death of PMIGM MacArthur Davis and the deaths of 28 of our Companions of this Jurisdiction. Our Grand Chaplain will have more on this later.

#### **DISPENSATIONS**

During the course of this year, I granted the following dispensations:

- (1) To Mobile Council #12 to elect and install an officer due to the death of an officer who had not been installed.
- (2) To Birmingham-Metro #43 to have a Zoom meeting (Virtual) in conjunction with their annual in person meeting.
- (3) To Florence Council#74 to hold their Annual election in July 2020.
- (4) To Eureka Council #5 to hold a special meeting to vote on a late petition.

#### **DECISIONS**

- (1) After being informed of irregular actions and the actions being investigated concerning the reinstatement of Companion and Sir Knight Branson Heath Fant, I healed him.
- (2) On receiving the request of Our Illustrious Grand Treasurer Ed Mason, requesting to be replaced as Grand Treasurer, 23, May 2020 I appointed Comp Thomas Nesbit to replace him. My thanks to Comp Mason for his many years of faithful service.
- (3) Upon receiving the request of Our Illustrious Grand Recorder Hiram O. Williams, to be replaced as Grand Recorder, On Oct 1, 2020 I appointed Comp James McGee to replace him. My thanks to Comp Williams for his many years of faithful service.
- (4) 1 October 2020, In reviewing our Grand Representatives for the Grand Council, it was my decision to add Representatives for the vacancies and remove those that have not been attending or making reports.
- (5) I met with the Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Right Eminent Grand Commander and our Secretary / Recorder to discuss our Annual Communication issues brought on by Covid-19. After serious study and prayer; it was decided that we could not meet our contractual obligations with Double Tree Hotel and that we would have to have an alternate plan. All Three Heads and their seconds were in agreement with our actions.

#### **REVEIW OF BOOKS**

I authorized our Illustrious Grand Recorder to turn over the books and financial records to the Audit Committee for review of the books of the Grand Council of Alabama for the 2020 fiscal year.

#### **VISITATIONS**

During the year I was privileged to represent The Alabama Grand Council in South Carolina. Additional visitations were made in State to various Masonic

#### Report of the Committee on Membership

To the Most Illustrious Grand Master and Companions of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama.

It is the responsibility of this committee to report the status of the subordinate councils. This past year has been a challenge to all of us. We are challenged with issues that Masonry has not had to face within the lifetimes of any of us. In

some case we have been able to leverage technology to come up with alternative methods to accomplish our tasks. But the inability to create new companions has impacted us significantly. The Blue Lodges were not able to initiate new Masons. Entered Apprentice and Fellowcraft Masons were not able to advance. In the Chapters, we were similarly not able to make or advance companions. Consequently, as a result, the pool of prospective members to the Councils was limited.

This year, like many prior years, we had negative growth within the Grand Council. But there is a ray of hope. For the past 3 years we have held fairly consistent with losses. This is because of the hard work of our companions within our local Councils. Last year, 1 Council showed a positive growth. This year 4 Councils showed positive growth and 3 Councils stayed the same. This is a start, but we must strive to maintain this effort. It will take a concerted effort, but our Fraternity is worth it. Deaths within our ranks have also taken a toll upon our rolls. Death is a constant and something over which we have no control. But there is one area where we do have control. The question is whether or not we want to put the time and effort into addressing it. That area is suspensions. Looking at our membership statistics, we can see that suspensions far outweigh the number of members lost to death. This year we lost 29 Companions who have laid down their working tools. That is unfortunate. But we also lost 58 Brothers who went suspended. That is twice as many suspensions as deaths. This is an area where we have the ability to make a significant difference.

These men have lost interest for some reason. We need to make the effort to find out why and how they lost the desire to be members of the Council of Royal & Select Masters. We need to reenergize the members who are not active members in our local Councils. Each subordinate Council should make the effort to reach out to its members who are in danger of suspension to determine how the Council can help them become active members again.

Our goal for next year should be positive growth in all Councils. This goal is within our reach.



#### NEW HOLDER OF CRYPTIC MASONS MEDICAL RESEARCH FOUNDATION CHAIR



The Indiana University School of Medicine is pleased to announce that Dr. Michael Murphy (L) will be the new holder of the Cryptic Masons Medical Research Foundation Chair. Dr. Murphy is board certified in surgery and vascular surgery, and is an international leader in the use of adult stem cells to treat vascular disease. In addition to his clinical and research experience, Dr. Murphy is a decorated veteran of two tours in Iraq, having received both the Meritorious Service Medal and Bronze Star.

'It is deeply meaningful to me to hold the Cryptic Masons Medical Research Foundation chair, said Murphy. The support that comes with an endowed chair will be instrumental in my being able to conduct research as a clinician and investigator by helping to assure that I will have the time to fully devote myself to these efforts."

#### PREVENTING AORTIC ANEURYSM RUPTURE WITH STEM CELLS



An aneurysm is an enlargement of the aorta that continues until it ruptures. When an aneurysm ruptures it is fatal in 80% of cases. The cause of aneurysm has been a mystery until recently when IU researcher, Dr. Linden Green (R), made a groundbreaking discovery. Dr. Green found that patients with aortic aneurysms have an imbalance in their immune system with an increase in cells that cause inflammation (ThI7 cells) and a decrease in cells that suppress inflammation, known as immune regulatory cells (Tr1 cells). So what if there was a way to increase Tr1 cells (the good guys) and decrease Th17 cells (the bad guys)? Would this prevent aortic aneurysms fron forming or enlarging? Dr. Green went back to the lab and treated models of aneurysms with mesenchymal stem cells (adult stem cells that can produce more than one type of specialized cell of the body). What she found exciting was that the stem cells significantly decreased the rate of expansion of aneurysms. With this data, supported by the Cryptic Masons, we designed the first abdominal aortic aneurysm clinical trial in the world, the ARREST Trial (AneuRysm Repression with mEsenchymal STem cells). The study is being conducted at the VA Hospital on the IU medical campus and the results so far show that there is a significant increase in TI cells after stem cell infusion. There is also very early evidence that aneurysms do not increase in size after stem cell treat-ment. This trial may provide a breakthrough treatment for patients with aneurysms of the aorta. trial may provide a breakthrough treatment for patients with aneurysms of the aorta.

#### HELPING FAILING HEARTS WITH STEM CELLS



Our vascular research group is participating in two exciting clinical trials as part of the Cardiovascular Cell Therapy Research Network that are using stem cells to help patients with heart failure. The CONCERT-HF Trial is recruiting patients with heart failure after a heart attack. A special kind of stern cell is collected from the heart tissue with a biopsy, called a "c-kit stern" cell. Patients also have a bone marrow blopsy from which stem cells are collected. The stem cells are injected directly into the wall of the heart with a NOGA catheter. The NOGA catheter is

able to identify the injured part of the heart and stem cells are injected to rebuild the heart tissue. Patients will be treated with c-kit cells alone, mesenchymal stem cells, c-kit cells plus mesenchymal stem cells, and a placebo. The SENECA Trial is recruiting patients with heart failure as result of having been treated with chemotherapy for cancer. This is the first study of its kind and if successful may provide cancer survivors new hope to enjoy a more active life after cancer treatment. treatment.

G....On August 4, 1947, Companion Willis E. Glazner was appointed Acting Grand Recorder following the death of Companion Guy T. Smith. H....At the Annual Assembly in 1947, Companion C. H. Stubinger was elected Grand Recorder

I....At the Annual Assembly of the Grand council of R. & S. M. of Alabama held on February 11, 1957, companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected Most Illustrious Grand Master to serve in that capacity during the election of officers. Most Illustrious Companion James M. Jones was elected Grand Recorder to serve for the same period of time.

J....On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas Leon Cochran was appointed Acting Grand Recorder K....On September 16, 1960, following the resignation of Companion T. L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Recorder.

L....On December 1, 1960 companion Varna A. Rushton was Appointed Grand Recorder to succeed Gordon L. Evatt who resigned M....Grand York Rite office was moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Recorder in 1962

N....At the Annual Assembly on February 1973 Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Recorder. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Recorder Emeritus. O....Annual Assembly date changed to last Monday in February.

P....As proof of continual effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council, and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974

Q....On November 1, 1974, The Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 5th Avenue South, Birmingham, AL 35222 R....On October 1, 1979 the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504  $\frac{1}{2}$  1st Avenue North, Birmingham, AL 35212 S....on May 16, 1980, James A Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to Succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.

T....At the Annual Assembly, February 1981 Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus Footnote Legend (continued):

U....On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Most Illustrious Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was appointed as Grand Recorder.

V....At the Annual Assembly in February 1992, Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and Most Illustrious Past Grand Master (Honorary). Companion James A. Y....On December 31st, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned and Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Grand Recorder.

Z....At the Annual Assembly in February, 2006 Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and Most Illustrious Past Grand Master (honorary). Most Illustrious Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected as Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Recorder.

AA...On February 28th, 2013 Illustrious Grand Principal Conductor of the Work Companion Jack A. Elliott Died. Most Illustrious George L. Marshall, Jr. according to the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama Constitution moved all elected officers up one position in line except the Deputy Grand Master, Treasurer and Recorder. He appointed Companion Raymond C. Dunn as Sentinel. This was done at a meeting of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama March 9th, 2013 at Birmingham Metro York Rite Temple 3430 Ratliff Road, Birmingham, AL with an effective date of April 1st, 2013. See the minutes attached to these proceeding.

AB...June 2018 Illustrious Grand Principal Conductor of the Work Companion Joshua Barney Lusk Died. Most Illustrious Ronald G. Andress according to the Grand Council Royal and Select Masters of Alabama Constitution moved all elected officers up one position in the line except the Deputy Grand Master, Treasurer and Recorder. He left the position of Illustrious Grand Steward open until our next annual Communication in February 2019, when 2 positions were needed to be elected, Illustrious Grand Conductor of the Work and the Illustrious Grand Steward

AC...On May 23, 2020 Edward L. Mason resigned as Illustrious Grand Treasurer Thomas H Nesbit was appointed Illustrious Grand Treasurer by MIGM Cooley. Illustrious Grand Recorder Hiram O. Williams, Jr. gave up the Recorder's place after 15 years of service on October 1st, 2020 MIGM Cooley appointed James C. McGee as the new Illustrious Grand Recorder.

AD...At the Annual Assembly February 2021, James C. McGee was elected Illustrious Grand Recorder and Thomas H Nesbit, was elected Illustrious Grand Treasurer. Hiram O. Williams was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and Edward L. Mason was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

### CHRONOLOGY Jeetings and Dates of Rodies Com

#### Titles of Meetings and Dates of Bodies Composed Exclusively of Masons

The ordinary calendar, or vulgar era, is not generally used by Freemasons in dating their official documents. They have one peculiar to themselves, differing according to their various Rites.

<u>ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS</u>: in all parts of the world, add 4,000 years to the Christian era, calling it Anno Lucis-Year of Light: abbreviated A.L. (this fact has a symbolic reference, not because they believe Freemasonry is, but that the principles and light of the

institution are coeval with the creation. (see below) F&AM Lodges hold "Communications."

<u>Royal Arch Masons:</u> date from the building of the second Temple-530 B.C. Their style is, therefore, Anno Inventionis-A. Inv. – in the year of discovery. Royal Arch Mason Chapters hold "Convocations."

Royal and Select Masters: date from the completion of Solomon's Temple 1000 B.C. Their style is Anno Depositionis-A. Dep.-in the year of Deposit. Royal and Select Councils hold "Assemblies."

<u>Knights Templar:</u> date from the organization of the Order in 1118 A.D. Their style is, therefore, Anno Ordinis-A.O.-in the year of the Order. Knights Templar Commanderies hold "Conclaves."

Order of the High Priesthood: dates from the blessing of Abraham by the High Priest Melchizedek, which occurred 1914 B.C. Their style is Anno Benedistionis-A.B.-in the year of Blessing. Councils of Anointed High Priest hold "Convocations."

Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite Masons: use the Jewish Calendar, which adds 3760 to the Christian era, style Anno Mundi-A.M.-year of the World. Or they sometimes use the Hebrew Year which begins on the seventeenth of September or feast of Tisri. Using the initials A.H.-Anno Hebraico.

<u>Temples, A.A.O.N. Mystic Shrine</u>: Each thirty years from the Hejira, or July 15<sup>th</sup>, A. D. 602 constitutes a cycle. Nineteen of these years contain 355 days, Eleven,356

<u>ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS:</u> Add 4,000 Years Thus:2019 + 4,000 = A.L. 6019

ROYAL ARCH MASONS: Add 530 Years. Thus: 2019 + 530= A. Inv. 2549

ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS: Add 1,000 Years Thus: 2019+1000= A. Dep. 3019

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR: Subtract 1,118 Years Thus: 2019-1118= A.O.901

ORDER OF HIGH PRIESTHOOD: Add 1,913 Years Thus:2019+1913= A.B. 3932

<u>SCOTTISH RITE MASONS</u>: Add 3,760 Years Thus: 2019+3760= A. M. 5779
