

# ADDRESS OF THE MOST ILLUSTRIOUS GRAND MASTER William A. Carter 2021-2022

To the Most Illustrious Grand Council, Royal and Select Masters of the State of Alabama

#### State of the Craft

The Councils of Cryptic Masons that I was able to visit this year were encouraging to me as I saw more interest in the Ritual, and continued support for other Councils in degree conferment and attendance.

#### Necrology

By the Grace of God, our Grand Line of Officers has remained unbroken this year. During the past year, several of our Companions have been called to Celestial

Lodge, including Most Illustrious Past Grand Master Charles Robert Pate. Our love and sympathy will continue to be with their families. Our Illustrious Grand Chaplain will have a full account in his report.

#### Dispensations

During the course of this year, I granted the following dispensations:

June 10, 2021- Brundidge Council #69 requested to move their July meeting one week later due to projected lack of attendance because the stated communication was on a holiday weekend.

July 22, 2021- Mobile Council #12 informed me that the Companion elected Principal Conductor of the Work resigned /declined to be installed in the position for personal reasons. Dispensation was granted for Mobile #12 to elect and install the Principal Conductor of the Work at the next stated meeting.

September 1, 2021- Brundidge Council #69 requested to move their September meeting one week later due to projected lack of attendance because the stated communication was on a holiday weekend.

September 14, 2021- Eureka Council #5 requested dispensation to elect and install a Companion to fill the Steward position out of turn. The reason given for the request was that the Companion who was elected at the Annual meeting refused the position and was not installed. The office of Steward was declared vacant. Dispensation was granted to elect and install the Steward out of turn.

November 22, 2021- Brundidge Council #69 requested approval to move their stated January meeting from January 1, 2022 one week later due to the stated meeting falling on a holiday. I granted Dispensation for Brundidge #69 to meet on January 8, 2022. I appreciate the Anniston Bodies for their efforts to meet when members are best able to attend.

#### **Decisions**

May 10, 2021

In consultation with MEGHP Roger Kim Harrison, REGC Winston L. Each, and Illustrious Grand Recorder James McGee, it was agreed that the Monroeville York Rite Bodies would forfeit the charters of each Body due to failure to meet since

December 2019. The Companions and Sir Knights who are in Good Standing will be sent notice that their affiliation will be assigned to the Mobile York Rite Bodies, or they will have the option of affiliating with a different York Rite or to request a Demit. My decision applies specifically to Monroeville Council #95.

#### July 30, 2021

Two members of the CMMRF committee communicated to me that they needed to step down due to other commitments or personal reasons. I thanked them for their willingness to serve the Grand Council. Companions Jason Hess and Brian Pierce were appointed to fill the remainder of the terms.

#### **Review of Books**

#### **Visitations**

Another virtual meeting that I was privileged to represent our Grand Council was the Most Illustrious Grand Council for the Federative Republic of Brazil for the installation of the new Grand Cryptic Council U.D. of Brazil.

I was able to attend Council or other York Rite meetings at nine of the Bodies. My regrets to Brundidge #69 and Florence #74. A special visit for me was to Eureka #5 to attend the 50 Year York Rite award to our Companion George Marshall. It was my honor to install officers at Montgomery #3, Tuscaloosa #4, Mobile #12, and Gadsden #56. I also attended the installation of officers at Dothan #68.



To recap a few past years 2016 we had 1391 members we donated \$2927.00, in 2017 we had 1260 members we donated \$2496.00 , in 2018 we had 1061 Members we donated \$3289.34, in 2019 we had 1072 members we donated \$3499.66, in 2020 we had 1017 members we donated \$7107.56 . My point for showing you these numbers is really simple . During one on the hardest times financially for some of us we stepped up WHY ? We lost members each year and still continued to adapt and overcome and still increase our help by donating more . CMMRF is teamed up with the University of Indiana as our research partners . Something I have been made aware of is the University has people that take our Donations and turn every dollar we give into \$7.00 for research. That being said what do they research. To name a few things Abdominal

Aortic Aneurysm ( it has 80% death rate ) however the research team feels that within a decade they will be able to cure it. Leg amputations, ( the 6th most expensive surgery in the U.S.)First completed stem cell therapy phase III Trail Significant reductions of leg amputations, helps patients with diabetes, CLI, and Gangrene. (Funded by Cryptic Masons) Diabetes, thanks to our CMMRF donations the Univ. was able to Support the ICVBM and purchase the Buchi encapsulation device that can made clinical grade capsules which will be used to make incapsuled human islet cells enabling them to test the ability to control blood sugar. Heart Failure, Pancreatitis, Pad, Stroke. Just to name some of the research our donations help perform. Now that we are working our way thru this pandemic personal opinion we should see a larger amount of donations. Companions I know every time we go somewhere we are asked to donate, buy a ticket, etc. We need to develop, train ourselves to ask for the money from others i.e. people, companies and other orders. But we still need to support ourselves. We can do more and must do more. We owe it to ourselves, our family and our HONOR to do our best . I don't believe we have when at the lowest points of our health and for a lot the lowest point of our financial situation for past two years we have stepped up and braced in the face of personal situations and did not WAVER, but stood straight. If we follow the same trend we have been doing we should exceed last year by at least \$2000.00. I pray that this year's donations will exceed last year's. I leave you with this I CAN DO ALL THINGS THOUGH CHRIST. Peace be with you.

McCluskey, Jr. was elected as Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Recorder.

AA...On February 28th, 2013 Illustrious Grand Principal Conductor of the Work Companion Jack A. Elliott Died. Most Illustrious George L. Marshall, Jr. according to the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama Constitution moved all elected officers up one position in line except the Deputy Grand Master, Treasurer and Recorder. He appointed Companion Raymond C. Dunn as Sentinel. This was done at a meeting of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama March 9th, 2013 at Birmingham Metro York Rite Temple 3430 Ratliff Road, Birmingham, AL with an effective date of April 1st, 2013. See the minutes attached to these proceeding.

BB...June 2018 Illustrious Grand Principal Conductor of the Work Companion Joshua Barney Lusk Died. Most Illustrious Ronald G. Andress according to the Grand Council Royal and Select Masters of Alabama Constitution moved all elected officers up one position in the line except the Deputy Grand Master, Treasurer and Recorder. He left the position of Illustrious Grand Steward open until our next annual Communication in February 2019, when 2 positions were needed to be elected, Illustrious Grand Conductor of the Work and the Illustrious Grand Steward. CC...Right Excellent Grand Treasurer Edward L. Mason gave up the Treasurer place due to health and on 05/23/2020 Thomas H Nesbit was appointed Grand Treasurer by MIGM Cooley. Right Excellent Grand Secretary Hiram O. Williams, Jr. gave up the Secretary's place after 15 years of service and on October 1st, 2020 MIGM Cooley appointed James C. McGee as the new Grand Secretary. These appointees will be voted on in the 2021 194th Annual Communication in February at Birmingham, AL.

#### **CHRONOLOGY**

### Titles of Meetings and Dates of Bodies Composed Exclusively of Masons

The ordinary calendar, or vulgar era, is not generally used by Freemasons in dating their official documents. They have one peculiar to themselves, differing according to their various Rites.

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS: in all parts of the world, add 4,000 years to the Christian era, calling it Anno Lucis-Year of Light: abbreviated A.L. (this fact has a symbolic reference, not because they believe Freemasonry is, but that the principles and light of the institution are coeval with the creation. (see below) F&AM Lodges hold "Communications."

Royal Arch Masons: date from the building of the second Temple-530 B.C. Their style is, therefore, Anno Inventionis-A. Inv. – in the year of discovery. Royal Arch Mason Chapters hold "Convocations."

Royal and Select Masters: date from the completion of Solomon's Temple 1000 B.C. Their style is Anno Depositionis-A. Dep.-in the year of Deposit. Royal and Select Councils hold "Assemblies." Knights Templar: date from the organization of the Order in 1118 A.D. Their style is, therefore, Anno Ordinis-A.O.-in the year of the Order. Knights Templar Commanderies hold "Conclaves." Order of the High Priesthood: dates from the blessing of Abraham by the High Priest Melchizedek, which occurred 1914 B.C. Their style is Anno Benedistionis-A.B.-in the year of Blessing. Councils of Anointed High Priest hold "Convocations."

<u>Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite Masons:</u> use the Jewish Calendar, which adds 3760 to the Christian era, style Anno Mundi-A.M.-year of the World. Or they sometimes use the Hebrew Year which begins on the seventeenth of September or feast of Tisri. Using the initials A.H.-Anno Hebraico.

<u>Temples, A.A.O.N. Mystic Shrine</u>: Each thirty years from the Hejira, or July 15<sup>th</sup>, A. D. 602 constitutes a cycle. Nineteen of these years contain 355 days, Eleven,356

#### **RULES FOR MASONIC DATES**

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS: Add 4,000 Years Thus:2019 + 4,000 = A.L. 6019

ROYAL ARCH MASONS: Add 530 Years. Thus: 2019 + 530= A. Inv. 2549

ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS: Add 1,000 Years Thus: 2019+1000= A. Dep. 3019

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR: Subtract 1,118 Years Thus: 2019-1118= A.O.901

ORDER OF HIGH PRIESTHOOD: Add 1,913 Years Thus:2019+1913= A.B. 3932

SCOTTISH RITE MASONS: Add 3,760 Years Thus: 2019+3760= A. M. 5779
