### INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

We have audited the accompanying statement of assets, liabilities and fund balance-cash basis of the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Alabama (a non-profit organization) as of December 31, 1989, and the related statements of revenue and expenses-cash basis and of changes in fund balance-cash basis for the year then ended. Those financial statements are the responsibility of Chapter's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

We conducted our audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

As described in Note 1, the Chapter prepares its financial statements on the basis of cash receipts and disbursements except that the statements include an inventory of supplies held for resale as well as a provision for depreciation of fixed assets. This basis is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles.

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the assets, liabilities, and fund balance of the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Alabama as of December 31, 1989, and its revenue and expenses and the changes in its fund balance for the year then ended, on the basis of accounting described in Note 1.

### NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS DECEMBER 31, 1989

### NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

### A. Basis of Accounting

The organization's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned, and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present financial position and results of operations in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles.

### B. <u>Inventories</u>

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the firstin, first-out method, or market.

### C. Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are recorded at cost and depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation is computed on the straight line method for financial reporting purposes.

### NOTE 2 - TAX STATUS:

The Chapter is exempt from federal income taxes under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c), and from state income taxes under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An informational tax return is filed each year on IRS Form 990.

To the Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Grand Officers, and Companions of the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Alabama:

The Alabama Grand York Rite Holding Company submits the following report: On August 25, 1989, a meeting of the Grand York Rite Holding Company was held in Birmingham, Alabama. The results of an election of officers for the ensuing year are: President, Emory J. Ferguson; Thomas W. Mann, Secretary; James A. Kile, Treasurer.

The lease on the office spaces of the Grand York Rite having expired in July, the discussion of a new lease was the main item of business. 


The new Grand High Priest, Companion Anthony M. Deming, was invested



- May, 1823: A small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were B
- January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted. p
- June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore re-organized in June, 1827, and a new constitution adopted. O
  - December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July. p
  - July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted. e
- No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14th, until the next evening: but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocations fixed for December. 8
  - In 1925 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
