To the Most Illustrious Gramd Master, Grand Officers, and Companions of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama:

We, your Finance Committee, submit the following report for your consideration.

We have examined the insurance coverage on the Grand Council and the bonds on the Grand Secretary and Grand Treasurer and the Review report by the C.P.A. and find them in order and recommend your approval.

The Budget is in the hand-out which has been passed out. There are three changes from the budget which you approved last year. One is on line item #802 Postage and Post Office Box Rent which we raised \$25.00 to \$225.00. On line item #823 Distinguished Guests there is a misprint in the budgeted amount which reads \$200.00 and should read \$500.00. Also the amount actually spent is incorrect and should read \$564.66. #### ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT

Mr. Anthony M. Deming Most Illustrious Grand Master Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama Birmingham, Alabama

We have reviewed the accompanying statement of assets, liabilities and fund balance - cash basis of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama (a non-profit organization) as of December 31, 1995, and the related statements of revenue and expenses - cash basis and of changes in fund balance - cash basis for the year then ended, in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. All information included in these financial statements is the representation of the management of the Council.

A review consists principally of inquiries of personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data. It is substantially less in scope than an audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, the objective of which is the expression of an opinion regarding the financial statements taken as a whole. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion.

Based on our review, we are not aware of any material modifications that should be made to the accompanying financial statements in order for them to be in conformity with the cash basis of accounting, as described in Note A.

Our review was made for the purpose of expressing limited assurance that there are no material modifications that should be made to the financial statements in order for them to be in conformity with the cash basis of accounting, as described in Note A. The information in the accompanying Schedule l is presented only for supplementary analysis purposes. Such information has been subjected to the inquiry and analytical procedures applied in the review of the basic financial statements. This information is presented on the cash basis of accounting, and we are not aware of any material modifications that should be made thereto.

# NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS DECEMBER 31, 1995

#### NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

# A. Basis of Accounting

The organization's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned, and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present financial position and results of operations in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles.

#### B. Inventories

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the first-in, first-out method, or market.

#### C. Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

#### NOTE 2 - TAX STATUS:

The Council is exempt from federal income taxes under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c), and from state income taxes under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An informational tax return is filed each year on IRS Form 990.


seen fit to leave our Grand Line unbroken. For this we give Him our Thanks. Let us observe a moment of prayer.

#### PERSONAL HISTORY

James Lathern Gossett was born August 5, 1924, in Piedmont, Alabama, the son of Alfred Max Gossett and Hicey Vanderford Gossett. The Piedmont native is a graduate of Piedmont High School, The Georgia Institute of Technology, and received an MBA from Alabama A & M University. Military schools included the Basic Airborne and Jumpmanster Courses of the Infantry School, Engineer Officer Career Course, Command and General Staff College, and the Air War College.

He married Jacqueline Lee Rhoton of Kingsport, Tennessee, on March 10, 1951. They have two sons: James Max Gossett of Seattle, Washington, and Rev. Michael Scott Gossett of Huntsville, Alabama. They also have three grandsons: David Scott, John Michael, and Seth Ward Gossett. James and Jackie live in Huntsville and are members of University Baptist Church.

Gossett served as a First Sergeant in World War II, received a direct commission in the Corps of Engineers, and served as a First Lieutenant during the Korean Conflict. He retired as a Colonel, AUS, with 35 years of active and reserve duty. He is also a retired industrial engineer, civil service, from the U.S. Army Missile Command, Redstone Arsenal, Alabama. He was involved in cost analysis (costing of missil systems) and is the author of several publications listed with the Defense Documentation Center, Alexandria, Virginia.

He served as Scoutmaster of American Legion Boy Scout Troop 120, Greenwood, South Carolina. He received the Distinguished Service Award, Huntsville/Madison County, AL, USA, Constitution Bicentennial Commission in 1987. He is a past Master of Kadosh of the Consistory for the year 1986, a past Venerable Master of the Lodge of Perfection for the year 1988, and is serving as Wise Master of the Chapter of Rose Croix for the year 1996. Elected a Knight Commander Court of Honour and invested with that distinction on November 7, 1987. He is serving as Commander of the Council of Knights Commander Court of Honor, Valley of Huntsville, for the year 1995-96. He is a member of the Million Dollar Club of the Scottish Rite Foundation of Alabama, served as Degree Master of the fourth Degree since 1988, and has served on the Finance Committee for several years.

James was made a Shriner in Zamora Temple, A.A.O.N.M.S., in Birmingham, on May 31, 1958. He transferred his membership and became a Charter Member of Cahaba Temple on July 16, 1970. He served with the Director's Staff Unit, later with the Blue Lodge Degree Team, and now with the Fireballs Unit. Noble Gossett was made a Life Member of Cahaba Temple on January 8, 1993.
