We, your Membership Committee, are pleased to submit the following report:

This year brought some changes to our membership rolls that were not a total surprise. With the changing of secretaries in some of our commanderies, and records being updated, we had some "one time" big number changes in membership.

We started this year with 969 active members in our Grand Commandery. We had eleven demits and one hundred-one to go suspended for non-payment of dues. Please understand, due to the cleaning up of the membership roll in our largest commandery in the state, it caused our numbers to change drastically. We now have a more accurate membership roll, which will help us to keep in better contact with our membership and slowdown the loss of our Sir Knights.

Unfortunately, we did loose fifty-two members to death this year. And there is nothing that can be done about this; other than to realize that the average age of our organization is high and we really need to try to recruit any of our younger blue lodge brethren which would help to bring down that overall average age.

This put us with an ending total of 894 members at the end of the year with a net change of minus 75 members, or a 7.74 % loss. However, we did see

seventeen Sir Knights get reinstated this past year, as well as, ten who affiliated with us. Also, we saw positive membership gains in five of the eleven commandries in our state. and we knighted sixty-two new Sir Knights in 2024. Which we find positive!

In conclusion, I believe that with the help of the Sir Knights of this Grand Commandery, we can build up our membership.

We would like to thank our Right Eminent Grand Commander, Sir Knight Sidney R. Cooley Sr. for allowing us to serve him this past year and thank him for his continued support.



### REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

To the Right Eminent Grand Commander, Grand Officers, and Sir Knights of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Alabama:

We are disappointed that due to the geopolitical risk in the Holy Land, the Grand Encampment decided it was best to postpone the 2024 pilgrimage. Our previous Pilgrim, Rev. Eddie Hodges of Dora who was nominated through Cyrene Commandery #10 remains ready to make his Pilgrimage once the area has been announced safe for travel.

The Committee recommends the same guidelines for next year in selecting ministers for the Pilgrimage.

- One Minister be selected in a competitive process from qualified minister nominated through the Commandery's.
- 2) The cost sharing program be continued for up to three qualified ministers in which we will pay the travel to and from New York City and the Grand Encampment expenses be borne by a group sponsoring the minister. The nomination form must still be approved by a Commandery in Alabama.

REGC called on PGC Teddy Grogan, to present on behalf of the Chairman of Jurisprudence the proposed amendments to the Constitution & ByLaws.

The following resolution was not received in time as per Article IX of the Grand Commandery Constitution. For the resolution to be received at the 165<sup>th</sup> Annual Conclave a 2/3 majority vote would be needed for the resolution to be presented. For the purpose of discussion SK Jim McGee, Grand Recorder moved the resolution be accepted. A 2/3 majority vote was received.

#### 2025 Legislative Call Call Item # 1

Proposed by: SK James C McGee, PGC, on behalf of the Finance Committee Purpose: to update the Constitution to current fees (THIS A FEE INCREASE)

Amend: Proposal to amend the Constitution

**Currently Reads** 

#### ARTICLE II

#### OF REVENUE

<u>Section 9.</u> The revenue of the Grand Commandery shall be derived from fees charged for Dispensations, Charters and other instruments issued under its authority, as follows:

(a) For a Dispensation, one hundred dollars (\$100.00), to be paid in advance. (b) For a Charter, twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), to be paid in advance.

And from the following contributions levied upon the constituent Commanderies:

(c)(i) For each Knight Templar borne upon the rolls at the date of the annual return, annual per capita dues of eighteen dollars (\$18.00) will be paid to the Grand Commandery. The amount of the annual per capita dues will be adjusted for inflation each year as put forth by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) as of December of each year.

- (ii) In accordance with Section 10 of the Constitution of the Grand Encampment, an annual per capita dues of nine dollars (\$9.00) per member each year is hereby levied upon each Grand and Subordinate Commandery of the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar of the United States of America, an additional assessment of one dollar (\$1.00) shall be levied upon any Sir Knight who is not a Life Sponsor of the Knights Templar Eye Foundation. Any increase in per capita tax by the Grand Encampment shall automatically increase the per capita specified in this section by a like amount.
- (d) Every Commandery shall be entitled to deduct from its annual per capita tax the amount of such tax for one year for each Knight shown on the current year's Annual Return as suspended N.P.D. provided such suspension was for two years non-payment of dues.
- (e) Every Commandery shall be required to remit to the Grand Commandery per capita tax for reinstated members for each year for which dues have been collected.
- (f) There shall be attached to the Annual Return of each Commandery making deductions or additions, as above prescribed, a certificate signed by the Recorder of the Commandery, explaining in detail the deductions or additions made.

To be amended to read;

#### ARTICLE II

- (ii) In accordance with Section 10 of the Constitution of the Grand Encampment, an annual per capita dues of nine dollars (\$9.00) per member each year is hereby levied upon each Grand and Subordinate Commandery of the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar of the United States of America, an additional assessment of one dollar (\$1.00) shall be levied upon any Sir Knight who is not a Life Sponsor of the Knights Templar Eye Foundation. Any increase in per capita tax by the Grand Encampment shall automatically increase the per capita specified in this section by a like amount.
- (d) Every Commandery shall be entitled to deduct from its annual per capita tax the amount of such tax for one year for each Knight shown on the current year's Annual Return as suspended N.P.D. provided such suspension was for two years non-payment of dues.
- (e) Every Commandery shall be required to remit to the Grand Commandery per capita tax for reinstated members for each year for which dues have been collected.
- (f) There shall be attached to the Annual Return of each Commandery making deductions or additions, as above prescribed, a certificate signed by the Recorder of the Commandery, explaining in detail the deductions or additions made.

A motion was made to amend the resolution to make the increase in Per Capita \$5.00 instead of the stated \$2 increase. The amendment passed. The amended resolution passed but failed to get a unanimous vote and will be held over until next year.

#### Foot Notes:

First Annual Conclave was held in Montgomery, Alabama on Friday November 30, 1860

Grand Commandery office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Recorder in 1962

(A)At the Annual Conclave, April 1963, Earl D. Holmes was elected and installed as Grand Commander, but he died before he could serve.

(B)At the Annual Conclave, April 1973 Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Recorder. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Recorder Emeritus, and the Annual Conclave Date was changed from April each year to the last Monday in February to correspond with Grand Chapter and Grand Council.

(C)As proof of continual effort of Alabama to promote York Rite unity, the first combined meeting of The Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.

On November 1, 1974 the Grand York Rite office was moved to 3621 South Fifth Avenue Birmingham.

In September 1979 the Grand York Rite office was moved to 5504 ½ North First Avenue Birmingham 35212.

On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.

At the Annual Conclave February 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

(D)On September 1, 1991 Thomas W. Mann and James A. Kile resigned as Grand Recorder and Grand Treasurer. Arthur C. Harding was appointed as Grand Recorder and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was appointed Grand Treasurer.

At the Annual Conclave February 1992, Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Recorder and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Treasurer. Thomas W. Mann was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and James A. Kile was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

(E)On June 23 1997. Past Grand Commander Robert L. Byars. Jr., renounced York Rite Masonry and is no longer a member.

On January 13, 1999 the Grand York Rite office moved to 3430 Ratliff Road, Irondale, AL 3510

(F)On December 31, 2005, Arthur C. Harding and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., resigned as Grand Recorder and Grand Treasurer, Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Grand Recorder and Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Grand Treasurer.

At the Annual Conclave February 2006, Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Recorder Emeritus and Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Hiram O. Williams, Jr., was elected Grand Recorder. Also Fred W. McCluskey, Jr., was elected Grand Commander Honorary.

February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2012 was the beginning of our Annual Meetings being held on the last Friday of February each year. This was presented in February 2010 and laid over until February 2011 on which the vote was taken and passed to meet on the last Friday of February each year.

(G)October 1st, 2013, Sir Knight Arthur Lee Campbell, III Eminent Grand Warder Resigned from Masonry with no reason stated.

(H)On May 25, 2020 Ed Mason resigned as Grand Treasurer. Thomas H. Nesbit was appointed Grand Treasurer. On October 1, 2020 Hiram O. Williams resigned as Grand Recorder. James C. McGee was appointed as Grand Recorder. At the Annual Conclave February 2021 James C. McGee was elected Grand Recorder and Thomas H. Nesbit was elected Grand Treasurer. Hiram O. Williams was elected as Grand Recorder Emeritus and Ed Mason was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.

(I)On January 15, 2021 Eminent Grand Generalissimo Thomas Lott resigned his position in the advancing line.

#### CHRONOLOGY

#### Titles of Meetings and Dates of Bodies Composed Exclusively of Masons.

The ordinary calendar, or vulgar era, is not generally used by Freemasons in dating their official documents. They have one peculiar to themselves, differing according to their various Rites.

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS in all parts of the world, add 4,000 years to the Christian era, calling it *Anno Lucis*-Year of Light; abbreviated A.L. (This fact has a symbolic reference, not because they believe Freemasonry is, but that the principles and light of the institution are coeval with the creation. (*See below*.) F&AM Lodges hold "Communications."

<u>ROYAL ARCH MASONS</u> date from the building of the second Temple-530 B.C. Their style is, therefore, *Anno Inventionis*-A. Inv. - in the year of the discovery. Royal Arch Chapters hold "Convocations."

<u>ROYAL AND SELECT MASONS</u> date from the completion of Solomon's Temple 1000 B.C. Their style is *Anno Depositionis*-A. Dep.-in the year of Deposit. Royal and Select Councils hold "Assemblies."

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR date from the organization of the Order in 1118 A.D. Their style is, therefore, *Anno Ordinis*-A.O.-in the year of the Order. Knight Templar Commanderies hold "Conclaves."

ORDER OF THE HIGH PRIESTHOOD dates from the blessing of Abraham by the High Priest Melchizedek, which occurred 1914 B.C. Their style is *Anno Benedistionis*-A.B.-in the year of the Blessing. Councils of Anointed High Priest hold "Convocations."

<u>ANCIENT AND ACCEPTED SCOTTISH RITE MASONS</u> use the Jewish Calendar, which adds 3760 to the Christian era, styled *Anno Mundi-A.M.*-year of the World. Or, they sometimes use the Hebrew year which begins on the seventeenth of September or feast of Tisri, using the initials A.H.-*Anno Hebraico*.

<u>TEMPLES, A.A.O.N. MYSTIC SHRINE</u>; Each thirty years from the Hejira, or July 15th, A.D. 602 constitutes a cycle. Nineteen of these years contain 355 days, Eleven, 356.

#### RULES FOR MASONIC DATES

<u>ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS</u> - Add 4,000 years. Thus: 2020 + 4,000 = A.L. 6020

ROYAL ARCH MASONS - Add 530 years.

Thus: 2020 + 530 = A. Inv. 2550

ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS - Add 1,000 years.

Thus: 2020 +1,000 years = A. Dep. 3020 KNIGHTS TEMPLAR - Subtract 1,118 years.

Thus: 2020 - 1,118 = A.O. 902 ORDER OF HIGH PRIESTHOOD - Add 1,913 years.

Thus: 2020 + 1,913 = A.B. 3,933

<u>SCOTTISH RITE MASONS</u> - Add 3,760 years. Thus: 2020 + 3,760 = A.M. 5780
