REPORT OF MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

To the Most Illustrious Grand Master and Companions of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama.

It is the responsibility of this committee to report the membership status of the subordinate councils.

It is important to note that the Birmingham Chapter did a deep audit of their membership records to correct their counts from previous years and report a more accurate count. This accounts for the increase in deaths and suspensions. A review of membership activity across the eleven subordinate councils shows a gain of 113 members (66 greeted, 27 affiliated, and 20 reinstated). Losses outnumbered the gains by 54 members with a total of 167 losses (12 demits, 105 suspended,50 died). Alabama shows 931 active members for 2024 and 985 from 2023.

Out of 11 Subordinate Councils, 6 had a positive gain and 5 lost members.

These numbers are significantly worse than last year. This year's losses totaled 54 as last year's total losses were 10. Unfortunately, we cannot do anything about the deaths. Suspensions have increased by almost 54%. Last year's suspension totaled 28 as this year's suspensions were 105. The increase in suspensions is very troubling.

An initiative was taken to reach out to brothers who were facing a suspension to talk about options. Sometimes that is all it took to bring someone back. Perhaps they were not receiving dues notices due to an address change that was not noted, or they may have been facing financial difficulties that impeded their ability to pay quickly. It is better to work with them to resolve whatever issue they are having so we do not lose them. Unfortunately, we failed in making this effort to reduce suspensions. This is not a daunting task. One must be bold enough to reach with an e-mail or quick phone call.

Our goal for our subordinate Councils next year should be to make a concerted effort to retain all our current members, continue to reach out to members in danger of suspension, and work to bring back members who have demitted to grow our Council.



REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CRYPTIC MASONS MEDICAL RESEARCH FOUNDATION

To the Most Illustrious Grand Master, Grand Officers, and Companions of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of Alabama.

Maria is a 23-year-old patient that has an auto-immune vascular disease and is in constant chronic pain, and has been for most of her life. She was prescribed methadone to control the pain, however methadone is not a good solution to chronic pain and created a condition where her life was impeded and she had no positive future to look forward to. She was also not qualified for bypass surgery or angioplasty. With her life at an all time low, she was entered into a clinical study where she was injected with stem cells designed to help her with the pain and serve as an alternate treatment to this disabling condition. This form of therapy is being researched and administered by the Indiana University School of Medicine. The treatments were a success and Maria is no longer reliant on methadone for pain control. She is pain free and has a bright future to look forward to. This is a direct result of the monies raised by CMMRF and provided to the Indiana University School of Medicine.

The CMMRF program continues to conduct critical research into Aortic Aneurysms, Peripheral Arterial Disease, Heart Failure, Diabetes, Cancer, Stroke, Arthritis, Pancreatitis and other chronic conditions in which millions of people suffer from. Last year we reported on a condition known as "Necrotizing Enterocolitis". This condition afflicts the intestinal systems of newborn babies and infants. This condition has a 50% mortality rate and posses a great threat to babies that have it. For the babies that do survive, they can expect long term intestinal and lung problems. Due to the research that we are supporting, a cure has been found and is being utilized to save these vulnerable lives. This alone, makes all of our efforts and support worthwhile; but more cures are on the

horizon and further treatments are being developed for all of the afflictions that we have previously reported on. Currently, 368 clinical trials are ongoing through the Indiana University school of Medicine.

In the latest news release from the research team for CMMRF, a new cell type has been discovered that has the potential to grow new blood vessels around dysfunctional blood vessels. This can prove to be life changing for those suffering from Peripheral Artery Disease (PAD), Diabetes, diabetic complications in the eyes, kidney issues, and heart disease.

A simplified description of this discovery could be explained as creating a permanent detour around road construction. So instead of a surgical heart bypass, we could simply

create a new set of roads around the blockage. The same can be said about any other blood vessel in the body. This is another breakthrough in the research done by CMMRF with PAD, but now it is another tool in our toolbelt. Imagine your doctor finding a heart blockage, but now the treatment is a quick stem cell treatment to restore the blood supply to your heart instead of open-heart surgery. Your donations are making this possible!

The year 2024 was a good year for the Grand Council of Alabama's CMMRF program. We raised \$ 12,447.00 in donations and fundraisers. We were not able to equal 2023 due to the fact that we were not able to get a venue to host our dinner, however 2025 have a venue secured in Pell City for a 2025 dinner. We expect this to be as successful as the dinner that we held in 2023. This will greatly enhance our charitable giving.

In addition to this, we will continue to extend our outreach to all of the Blue Lodges of Alabama. A new letter will be sent to each blue lodge educating them on the CMMRF program and asking for their support. This year, we will be doing this in conjunction with CMMRF month. Blue Lodges around the state, have supported us in the past and we are appreciative of their continued support. We also hope to expand beyond Masonry groups and get the participation of our local communities as well. We will also be looking at additional fundraising events that we hope will be supported.

In this New Year, we will keep the momentum of 2024 going and achieve even higher goals and aspirations. Our educational efforts will be expanded this year and we will strive to bring you all of the exciting advancements being made by the Indiana University School of Medicine.

On the national and international fronts, the month of March has been proclaimed as CMMRF month in which we will educate, inform and include all in our efforts to expand this program. We will be requesting that each York Rite Council support the program with a \$ 100.00 donation. This is the goal that the General Grand Council has set for CMMRF month and we fully support this goal.

Another way to donate is through the "Marion Crumb Foundation" which allows anyone wishing to make a \$ 100.00 donation, will receive a certificate making them a fellow, and a medal that can be displayed of the purple jacket. This money does go directly too CMMRF.

In conclusion, I would like to share this quote:

The CMMRF is about making the world a better place through medical research. It is anticipated that in the next 20 years, this research will allow for the creation of new replacement organs to be grown in 3D printers with the use of the individuals stem cells and allowing for organs that do not have the rejection concerns of donated organs. This may sound like a science fiction story; however, it is real and will happen. The Indiana School of Medicine is a fore runner in this research.

Charity is what allows us, through collective means, to make a positive difference in the lives that surround us. The CMMRF program, as well as the research conducted at the Indiana University School of Medicine is what will allow us to take a few dollars from all of us and turn it into solutions that affect all of our families, friends and neighbors. Each and every donation, no matter how large or small, is leading us to a day when we can cure the ill of the afflictions that the CMMRF program is supporting, and the Indiana University School of Medicine is researching. Blessings to all!!!

CHRONOLOGY

Titles of Meetings and Dates of Bodies Composed Exclusively of Masons

The ordinary calendar, or vulgar era, is not generally used by Freemasons in dating their official documents. They have one peculiar to themselves, differing according to their various Rites.

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS: in all parts of the world, add 4,000 years to the Christian era, calling it Anno Lucis-Year of Light: abbreviated A.L. (this fact has a symbolic reference, not because they believe Freemasonry is, but that the principles and light of the institution are coeval with the creation. (see below) F&AM Lodges hold "Communications."

<u>Royal Arch Masons:</u> date from the building of the second Temple-530 B.C. Their style is, therefore, Anno Inventionis-A. Inv. – in the year of discovery. Royal Arch Mason Chapters hold "Convocations."

Royal and Select Masters: date from the completion of Solomon's Temple 1000 B.C. Their style is Anno Depositionis-A. Dep.-in the year of Deposit. Royal and Select Councils hold "Assemblies." Knights Templar: date from the organization of the Order in 1118 A.D. Their style is, therefore, Anno Ordinis-A.O.-in the year of the Order. Knights Templar Commanderies hold "Conclaves." Order of the High Priesthood: dates from the blessing of Abraham by the High Priest Melchizedek, which occurred 1914 B.C. Their style is Anno Benedistionis-A.B.-in the year of Blessing. Councils of Anointed High Priest hold "Convocations."

<u>Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite Masons:</u> use the Jewish Calendar, which adds 3760 to the Christian era, style Anno Mundi-A.M.-year of the World. Or they sometimes use the Hebrew Year which begins on the seventeenth of September or feast of Tisri. Using the initials A.H.-Anno Hebraico.

<u>Temples, A.A.O.N. Mystic Shrine</u>: Each thirty years from the Hejira, or July 15th, A. D. 602 constitutes a cycle. Nineteen of these years contain 355 days, Eleven,356

RULES FOR MASONIC DATES

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS: Add 4,000 Years Thus:2019 + 4,000 = A.L. 6019

ROYAL ARCH MASONS: Add 530 Years. Thus: 2019 + 530= A. Inv. 2549

ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS: Add 1,000 Years Thus: 2019+1000= A. Dep. 3019

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR: Subtract 1,118 Years Thus: 2019-1118= A.O.901

ORDER OF HIGH PRIESTHOOD: Add 1,913 Years Thus:2019+1913= A.B. 3932

SCOTTISH RITE MASONS: Add 3,760 Years Thus: 2019+3760= A. M. 5779
