ADDRESS OF THE GRAND HIGH PRIEST Michael Feld 2024-2025

To the Officers, Past Grand High Priests, Companions and Distinguished Guests of the Most Excellent Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of the State Alahama:

It is an honor to welcome you to the One Hundred and Ninety Eighth Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Alabama. I hope that this session will be an enjoyable, educational, and productive experience for you. Let us celebrate the work we accomplished and prepare for the work ahead. This is your opportunity to create and renew fraternal bonds across the state of Alabama and with visiting Companions from foreign jurisdictions. On behalf of all companions of the Grand Chapter of Alabama, we appreciate and welcome our guests from other grand jurisdictions. Please let us know if you have any needs during your stay and we will serve as friends, brothers, and Companions should.

State of the Craft

The enthusiasm and efforts of old and new Companions has made great progress in recent years and the Grand High Priests and active members of the Grand Chapter, and Chapters this year and before. New efforts for traveling degrees to take Capitular Masonry out to welcoming lodges has revitalized an interest in the lessons and benefits contained in the Chapter degree of recognizing good work as taught in the Mark Master degree, of leading in humility and consistency on foundational principles as taught in the Past Master degree, of teaching and setting an example as taught in the Most Excellent Master, and of taking on the most humble work and rediscovering the original purpose of Freemasonry as taught in the Royal Arch.

To this end, Companions Hoyt Brown and Houston Brown proposed the Signet Award for active Companions. I was asked "why do we need another award?" The Signet Award distinguishes itself from other awards because a Companion can achieve this by his individual merit performing specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, timely goals that benefit the Lodge, the Chapter, and our Masonic philanthropy. Whereas the Bronze Award should be justified by answering the question, "why did he receive it?", the Signet Award asks the question "why have you not achieved it?"

If every Companion achieved this award, the potential is that the Grand Lodge membership would grow each year equivalent to the total number of

Companions- 900 or more per year. Our RARA contributions would break records. There would be so many Companions willing and capable to support conferrals of degrees, we would be trying to solve the problem of how we could confer them more often. For anyone who questions if this is realistic, the way to refute it is this – have 5 members of your Chapter earn the Signet and your membership decrease. If you have 5 members in your Chapter earn the Signet Award for the 2025-2026 year, and your membership decreases, I will don't \$100 to your Chapter.



C. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore reorganized in June, 1827 and a new constitution adopted.

- D. May, 1823: A Small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- E. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.

CHRONOLOGY

Titles of Meetings and Dates of Bodies Composed Exclusively of Masons

The ordinary calendar, or vulgar era, is not generally used by Freemasons in dating their official documents. They have one peculiar to themselves, differing according to their various Rites.

<u>ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS</u>: in all parts of the world, add 4,000 years to the Christian era, calling it Anno Lucis-Year of Light: abbreviated A.L. (this fact has a symbolic reference, not because they believe Freemasonry is, but that the principles and light of the institution are coeval with the creation. (see below) F&AM Lodges hold "Communications."

<u>Royal Arch Masons:</u> date from the building of the second Temple-530 B.C. Their style is, therefore, Anno Inventionis-A. Inv. – in the year of discovery. Royal Arch Mason Chapters hold "Convocations."

<u>Royal and Select Masters:</u> date from the completion of Solomon's Temple 1000 B.C. Their style is Anno Depositionis-A. Dep.-in the year of Deposit. Royal and Select Councils hold "Assemblies."

<u>Knights Templar:</u> date from the organization of the Order in 1118 A.D. Their style is, therefore, Anno Ordinis-A.O.-in the year of the Order. Knights Templar Commanderies hold "Conclaves"

Order of the High Priesthood: dates from the blessing of Abraham by the High Priest Melchizedek, which occurred 1914 B.C. Their style is Anno Benedistionis-A.B.-in the year of Blessing. Councils of Anointed High Priest hold "Convocations." Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite Masons: use the Jewish Calendar, which adds 3760 to the Christian era, style Anno Mundi-A.M.-year of the World. Or they sometimes use the Hebrew Year which begins on the seventeenth of September or feast of Tisri. Using the initials A.H.-Anno Hebraico.

<u>Temples, A.A.O.N. Mystic Shrine</u>: Each thirty years from the Hejira, or July 15th, A. D. 602 constitutes a cycle. Nineteen of these years contain 355 days, Eleven,356

RULES FOR MASONIC DATES

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONS: Add 4,000 Years Thus:2019 + 4,000 = A.L. 6019

ROYAL ARCH MASONS: Add 530 Years. Thus: 2019 + 530= A. Inv. 2549

ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS: Add 1,000 Years Thus: 2019+1000= A. Dep. 3019

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR: Subtract 1,118 Years Thus: 2019-1118= A.O.901

ORDER OF HIGH PRIESTHOOD: Add 1,913 Years Thus:2019+1913= A.B. 3932

<u>SCOTTISH RITE MASONS</u>: Add 3,760 Years Thus: 2019+3760= A. M. 5779
